### INCREASE IN CALIFORNIA TAKEOUT

The takeout on pari-mutuel wagering throughout California will increase as of January 1 to provide funds to build and operate a drug testing facility for horses racing in the state. The increase of 0.1 percent for all wagers takes effect under Senate Bill 518, sponsored by Sen. Ken Maddy. The increase will be divided 0.33 percent to continue existing equine research and 0.67 percent for building and operating a drug testing facility at the University of California, Davis.

### TOTAL HANDLE UP IN NEW YORK FOR 1993

Daily average total handle at New York Racing Association tracks during the 303-day racing season in 1993 edged up slightly over '92 figures, gaining less than one percent for a daily average of \$7,260,257 as compared to \$7,200,306 the previous year. On-track handle dipped 2 percent, from \$2,637,221 in '92 to \$2,584,201 in '93. On-track attendance showed a decline of 4.2 percent, with an average of 11,547 for 1993.

### AUTOPSY RESULTS ON MEADOW

**RENDEZVOUS** An autopsy performed on the two-year-old filly Meadow Rendezvous at UC Davis revealed a heart problem as the cause of death. The top Northern California juvenile was found dead in her stall at Bay Meadows Dec. 18. According to Dr. Dean Goeldner, official veterinarian for the California Horse Racing Board, the filly had a degenerative condition of the heart. "The muscle cells of the heart were being replaced by fibrous tissue," said Goeldner. "The doctors are not sure what caused it, but it had been going on for awhile and it caught up with her." The stakes winner was not insured.

This weekend marks the start of what promises to be a very competitive and interesting winter of racing in Florida, kicking off with graded stakes doubleheaders Saturday and Sunday at Calder. In the Tropical Park H., **Migrating Moon** (Silver Buck) will be favored to win his seventh straight, but that result is unlikely, as he will be spotting weight to by far the toughest field he has ever faced, and figures to lose ground on the turns.

Maryland Jockey Club President Joseph De Francis has scheduled a press conference for this Monday, January 3 at the Laurel Clubhouse. De Francis will discuss his application for a Virginia racetrack license and will answer related questions regarding the operations of Laurel and Pimlico.

**SANTA ANITA OFFICER RESIGNS** Glennon E. King, an officer of Santa Anita Operating Co. and its subsidiary, the Los Angeles Turf Club, resigned from those companies Thursday to pursue other interests. King, who was in his 20th year with Santa Anita and most recently served as vice president-finance and assistant secretary for both companies, will relocate to Las Vegas.

The most likely winner is **Take Me Out** (Cure the Blues), who last time out ran very well in his first two-turn start in a long, long time. Take Me Out is favorably weighted and well drawn, and his last five figures should be good enough to win this. The biggest threat is probably the erratic **Technology** (Time For A Change).

The co-featured La Prevoyante, like many filly and mare grass handicaps, is a real scramble. The live longshot is **Amal Hayati** (Seattle Song), who had the misfortune to draw the outside post in a three-turn race. We still like her, but with somewhat diminished enthusiasm. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many horsemen and professional handicappers to evaluate the ability of racehorses. Multi-millionaire winner of the GI Hollywood Turf Cup last time out, **Fraise** (Strawberry Road) cedes from eight to 16 pounds to his 12 rivals in the McKnight. The Kentucky-bred horse will again have the services of Chris McCarron, who belatedly picked up the mount on **Fraise** in the Hollywood Turf Cup and guided him to a six-length victory. Ready to take on the favorite is **Glyer** (Seattle Dancer), who finished fourth in the GIII Tropical Turf H. last time out. "He came out of the race great," said trainer Randy Mills. "I feel that his last two stakes races were too short, so we've really been looking to send him longer. We actually had this race in mind ever since he came over from Ireland. He loves Florida, loves the humidity." Second highweight will be carried by **Awad** (Caveat), a Maryland-bred winner of over \$500,000. The turning four-year-old was eighth in the GI Rothmans last out Oct. 17, but took the Maryland Million Turf and the GI Secretariat at Arlington in two previous starts; he is two-for-three with jockey Jorge Velasquez in the saddle.
