JEFF LUKAS SHOWS PROGRESS Jeff Lukas remains in critical condition at Huntington Memorial Hospital, but his father, D. Wayne Lukas, said there were some encouraging developments. "He's still in a coma for the 19th day, but he moved his hands a couple of times (Saturday) and he opened his eyes a bit. I was hoping they would upgrade his condition to serious, but they didn't."

ARCANGUES BREEZES Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Arcangues** (Sagace) had his first breeze since that 133-1 upset Sunday morning, going three-eighths in :39 1/5 at Santa Anita. "We didn't do much, just basically gave him the feel of it," said trainer Richard Mandella. "He's still a long ways off."

FANS CAMPAIGN FOR ECLIPSE FOR JOHN LONGDEN The Fans' Committee of the California Horse Racing Industry Coalition has launched a campaign to get retired jockey John Longden an Eclipse Award of Merit. The committee is chaired by David Pascale, who said, "This is a recognition that is long overdue for one of the great athletes of the century." Longden retired as the world's winningest jockey in 1966--five years before Eclipse Awards were established. A resolution in favor of this honor was sent by the committee to the Thoroughbred Racing Associations, Daily Racing Form and National Turf Writers Association.

ELIZA NEARS FIRST WORKOUT Trainer Alex Hassinger reported Sunday that the 1992 champion two-year-old filly **Eliza** (Mt. Livermore) is about two weeks away from her first workout as she prepares for a return to the races. The '92 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner made her last start in the GII Princess S. June 19, finishing fourth by eight and a quarter lengths.

Odds-on favorite **Fraise** had to settle for the third spot as 29-1 **Cobblestone Road** went directly to the lead and never relinquished it, winning by a length and a quarter under jockey Jose Ferrer. "He was so relaxed the first part--just galloping in front," said Ferrer. "It was just a tremendous race." Added trainer Oliver Edwards, "This has been our biggest win. Just think--we beat the big boys from California and New York. We told Ferrer to 'go to the front and don't look back.' He was the only speed in the race; he rode exactly as we asked." Jockey Chris McCarron said of his mount, **Fraise**, "He went by the grandstand o.k., but he bobbed a little on the turn when he hit a soft spot and he never really got in the bridle again. I was thinking that it might be a little firmer on the rail, but I never really got the chance to find out. I couldn't ever get there. I guess I was happy with the way he persevered, and he ran pretty well, but he never really blasted off like he did last time." The six-year-old is scheduled to start next in Gulfstream's Pan American H.

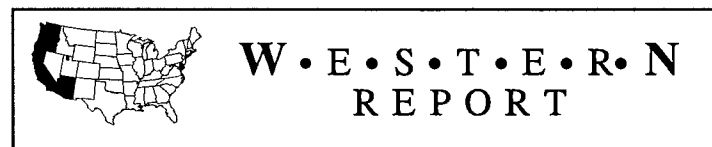
