Zeitlin was formerly vice president of The Jockey Club Information Systems, Inc. and general partner in EGRP.

### LEMON SOUFFLE UNDERGOES SKIN GRAFT

**Lemon Souffle**, one of the top two-year-old fillies in Europe last year, is currently in Lambourn, England's Valley Equine Hospital recovering from a skin-graft operation. The treatment, carried out early Wednesday morning, was necessitated by an injury suffered in Newmarket's Chevely Park S. Sept. 29. Lemon Souffle was struck from behind and suffered a gash to the flesh and tendon of her off-hind leg. While the tendon damage was limited, the flesh wound had been slow to heal and surgery was decided upon in order to speed her recovery. The filly is ante-post favorite for the '94 1,000 Guineas.
