## CHBPA DENIES BAY MEADOWS

**PURSE HIKE** The request by Bay Meadows to raise purses 20 percent across the board effective Jan. 12 has been turned down by the California Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association. In denying the request, Fordell Fierce, Chairman of the CHBPA's Northern Liaison Committee, stated that it was the unanimous opinion of the committee that "any accumulating purse underpayment should be paid out retroactively to all owners participating at the Bay Meadows Operating Co. race meeting, rather than over the final 14 days of the meet." Since the Christmas break, attendance has been up 18 percent and handle is up 37 percent at Bay Meadows over the same days last season.

## NEW YORK TO INSTITUTE 'QUICK

**OFFICIAL'** The New York stewards announced yesterday that the 'quick official' will be instituted for races at Aqueduct sometime within the next week. It will be used on a trial basis during this winter's simulcast period. With the 'quick official', a race may be declared official by the stewards before the jockeys weigh in after the race. Any objections by jockeys can be filed via a two-way communications between outriders and stewards.

**JEFF LUKAS MAKES PROGRESS** Jeff Lukas remains in a coma at Huntington Memorial Hospital, but his father, trainer D. Wayne Lukas, said his son continues to show encouraging signs. "It's a very gradual, long process, but he's trying to come out of it a little bit," said the elder Lukas. "He lapses in and out, moving his hands and opening his eyes, but he's making good progress."

Although his figures are good, they are offset by the fact that he must spot weight in this handicap; while he is a contender, he is no value at a short price.

Local hero **Carterista** (Dr. Carter) doesn't lose very often in south Florida, but, like Migrating Moon last week, must now spot serious weight to much better horses than he has been beating.

Well, Kissin Kris ran once on the turf as a two-year-old, and his figure that day was right in line with his dirt figures at that point in his career. That, combined with a serious grass pedigree, indicates he should run his race Saturday. The short stretch of Gulfstream's turf course combined with Kissin Kris' running style will probably cause him to lose ground, but unless he is forced extremely wide, he is the most likely winner.

The live longshot is **Elite Jeblar (Jeblar)**, who ran a real big one in early November, then had his form compromised when he raced three times in 15 days. Given normal rest, he improved in his latest and is pointing at his best. Well drawn and in light, he has a good shot at a big price.
