PURSE INCREASE AT TURF PARADISE Turf Paradise President Robert L. Walker has announced a third purse increase for the 1993-94 meet. Daily purses will increase an average of \$1800 a day effective Wednesday, Jan. 12 as a result of a nine percent increase in wagering over last year. Through 81 days of racing, the in-state daily handle is averaging \$535,990 compared to \$406,443 last year. Total in-state handle is \$43.4 million, up 22 percent (nearly \$7 million) from the previous season.

STAKES MARES RETIRED Trudy McCaffery and John Toffan's pair of stakes mares, **Visible Gold** (Deputy Minister) and **Pacific Squall** (Storm Bird), have been retired from racing and will be shipped to Glenwood Farm in Versailles, Kentucky to be bred. Visible Gold ended her career with a decisive allowance victory at Santa Anita Saturday; she will be bred to Seattle Slew. GI winner Pacific Squall will go to Mane Minister.

FILLY WITH A FUTURE While Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Cardmania was clocked in 1:21.23 for his victory in Saturday's Gil San Carlos H., a three-year-old filly by the name of **Lakeway** (Seattle Slew) impressed two races earlier with a last-to-first win in a seven-furlong Santa Anita allowance run in a sharp 1:21.34. The Mike Rutherford homebred is out of a full sister to the undefeated GI winner Saratoga Six, and is herself undefeated in two starts; she is scheduled to go next in the GI Las Virgenes Feb. 20.

LAUREL CANCELS The jockeys' decision to discontinue riding at Laurel Sunday forced the cancellation of racing following the second event. The presence of frozen clods in the racing surface and sub-freezing temperatures were cited as reasons for halting the program after the early double.

Average price at Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Inc.'s Winter Mixed sale was \$4,533, down 11.9% from the comparable '93 sale when 127 lots averaged \$5,145.

This year's one-day venue sold 144 horses for gross receipts of \$652,800, with only 25 not reaching their reserved price. Last year, 41 did not sell. Matriarch S.-G1 victress **AUSPICIANTE (Arg)** (*Practicante--Auxey, by Right of Way), a MGSW in both NA and Arg., sold for \$55,000 to Live Oak Stud to top the sale.
