RACING CANCELLATIONS For the second straight day, racing was cancelled at Gulfstream Park due to the muddy condition of the main track caused by rain overnight; morning clouds kept the track from drying out sufficiently to hold Friday's card. Racing was also called off after Friday's first race at Aqueduct; the jockeys met following the first and decided not to continue riding. Philadelphia Park cancelled yesterday as well. With the forecast calling for severe cold today, Laurel Race Course has already cancelled its live card for Saturday, and will offer free admission and simulcasting from Gulfstream, Fair Grounds and Bay Meadows. Turfway Park cancelled its cards for Friday evening and Saturday afternoon.

PLANS FOR VALIANT NATURE, BIEN BIEN Trainer Ron McAnally reported yesterday that Hollywood Futurity winner **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty) will likely pass the El Camino Real Derby at Bay Meadows Jan. 22 in favor of the San Rafael S. March 6. **Bien Bien** (Manila) worked seven furlongs in 1:27 2/5 at Santa Anita Friday prepping for the GII San Marcos at a mile and a quarter on the turf January 29.

KEENELAND STAKES SCHEDULE Sixteen stakes worth a total of \$1,925,000 will be run during Keeneland's 16-day, April 8-29 spring meet. Twelve are graded races, and eight will be run on the turf. Highlight of the meeting is the GII \$500,000 Blue Grass Stakes, which will be sponsored by Delta Air Lines and run April 16--three weeks before the Derby. Three of the last four Derby winners prepped in the Blue Grass: Unbridled ('90), Strike the Gold ('91) and Sea Hero ('93). Three-year-old fillies will compete in the GI \$250,000 Ashland at a mile and a sixteenth April 23. Keeneland will race five days a week in April, with Mondays and Tuesdays dark.

Thoro-Graph Analysis for the El Encino

Santa Anita's La Canada series gives four-year-old fillies a chance to duck their elders, and since Hollywood Wildcat is passing Saturday's El Encino the lesser lights get an opportunity to shine. **Mamselle Bebette** (Copelan) and **Golden Klair** (Damister) both won stakes last time out at big prices and will be shorter this time, but both also ran lifetime top efforts and figure to react with poorer performances this time. The race looks to come down to **Vinista** (Jade Hunter) and **Sensational Eyes** (Roman Majesty), both of which were beaten favorites last time. Vinista is developing into a solid graded stakes filly who never runs a bad one on dirt or grass and is favorably weighted. Sensational Eyes is more erratic--she ran a huge race to win on Cal Cup Day and, not surprisingly, bounced next time out at 3-5. With two months rest and big workouts, she should once again be ready for her best. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many horsemen and professional handicappers to evaluate the ability of racehorses. Three-year-olds go a mile and seventy yards in the \$50,000a Count Fleet S. at Aqueduct. Heading the race, which was won last year by Prairie Bayou, is **Personal Merit** (Turkoman), second by a nose in the GIII Remsen last out and a winner of three of five lifetime; the Suffolk Downs shipper will face another traveller, the undefeated **Can't Be Denied** (Linkage), two-for-two at Laurel and making his stakes debut.
