## MEAFARA INJURED, OUT OF SANTA

**MONICA Meafara** (Meadowlake), who would have been heavily favored in Monday's GI Santa Monica H. at Santa Anita, has been injured and will miss the race. "She worked Wednesday and after she cooled out, she seemed to tie up," said trainer Rafael Becerra. "Her whole left side seemed to be sore." Meafara is stabled at Hollywood under the supervision of Marty Jones, son of trainer Gary Jones who is currently serving a 30-day suspension.

**JAPAN CUP WINNER HEADED FOR U.S.** The winner of the 1993 Japan Cup, **Legacy World** (Mogami), will be shipped to California to run in Santa Anita's \$400,000 San Juan Capistrano H. April 24. The five-year-old gelding will be flown to the U.S. two weeks prior to the Grade I event and will be stabled with trainer Richard Mandella's string at the Arcadia oval.

## 1993 BIG SPORT OF TURFDOM TO

**MCCARRON** Jockey Chris McCarron has been voted the 1993 "Big Sport of Turfdom" by the Turf Publicists of America. The award, which has been presented annually for 28 years, recognizes a racing personality who has enhanced the sport through their cooperation with media. The presentation will be made Friday, February 4 in New Orleans.

**ITSALLGREEKTOME RETURNS TO THE RACES MONDAY** Seven-year-old **Itsallgreetome** (Sovereign Dancer), the 1990 Eclipse Award winner as champion turf horse, will make his first start since November, 1992 at Santa Anita Monday. The GI winner is entered in the third race, a \$55,000 turf allowance at a flat mile; Eddie Delahoussaye rides.

**Pleasant Tango** (Pleasant Colony) is favored on the morning line in his first start as a four-year-old. The Buckland Farm colt has been on the board in half his 12 career starts, including a good third at this distance and over this track in the GII Goodwood H. October 17. **Bat Eclat** (Batonnier) has proven himself a solid turf runner with a four-for-six record; he has also been on the board in five of seven on the dirt and finished a good fourth to Diazo in the Malibu last time out. The Cal-bred gelding drops two pounds off that race and he should appreciate the added distance of the San Fernando.

**Southern Truce** (Truce Maker) hasn't raced since finishing third in the Cal Cup Matron October 16; the former claimer has not raced at a distance as short as seven furlongs in her last 10 starts. "I'm concerned that there are horses in the race who won't get tired enough for her to get to them," said trainer Roger Stein. "Even without Meafara, you still have Cargo and Arches of Gold, and they may not come back. But even if she runs third or fourth, it should get her good and tight--and it is a Grade I race."

"The outside post was the whole secret," said trainer Wally Dollase. "She was able to relax out there. As for what's next, I don't know right now. I doubt if she can get a mile and an eighth (in the La Canada, Feb. 5), especially with a little horse called Hollywood Wildcat." Favored Golden Klair was last early and did not rally. "She never tried to run today," said her jockey, Chris McCarron.

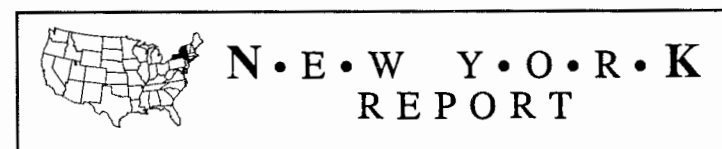
