**DAY HITS THE TOP TEN** Jockey Pat Day became only the 10th rider in history to reach the 6,000 victory mark when he piloted Miss Popsnorkle to her maiden win in Oaklawn's first race yesterday. "The quest for excellence never changes," said Day, "but priorities do. The championships and milestones are important parts of my life, but not as much as my religion and my family." The 6,000th winner was trained by Pete Vestal, who had also conditioned Day's 5,000th winner, Screen Prospect.

**DEHERE PREPS FOR HUTCHESON; NEEDS RIDER** Eclipse Award winner Dehere (Deputy Minister) had his final workout for Sunday's GII Hutcheson S. at Gulfstream yesterday afternoon between races, going a strong five furlongs in :57 4/5 under jockey Jerry Bailey. Last year's champion two-year-old went the last eighth in :11 in preparation for his '94 debut. Bailey is committed to ride Cray (Mt. Livermore) in the Hutcheson, but jockey Chris McCarron will not be available to ride Dehere Sunday, either--he was handed a five-day suspension for his ride in the seventh race at Santa Anita Jan. 22 and will serve his suspension Jan. 27 through Feb. 2.

**MEAFARA HEADS FOR KENTUCKY** Meafara (Meadowlake) will leave California for Shadwell Farm in Lexington, Kentucky Wednesday to begin her new career as a broodmare. Ironically, she will be bred to Dayjur (Danzig), the horse best remembered for finishing second after jumping a shadow just before the wire in the 1990 Breeders' Cup Sprint. Meafara was second by a neck in the past two BC Sprints.

**TELLY SAVALAS LOSES BATTLE WITH CANCER** Actor and racehorse owner Telly Savalas, well known as Kojak, the cop with the lollipop, died Saturday of prostate cancer. He was 70.

Favored INDIVIDUAL STYLE dueled with second choice Argolid through the entire seven furlongs, getting his neck in front at the wire to win under jockey Chris Antley. It was the colt's sixth win from eight career starts. "I knew they weren't going to give us an easy lead and, sure enough, Baffert's horse went with him most of the way," said the winning trainer, Lin Wheeler. "I don't know what's next. I'd rather keep him sprinting; I don't know that there are a whole lot of sprint races around, so there's some talk of turning him out...he has run quite a bit." Individual Style has won at distances from five furlongs to a mile and a sixteenth, but he is not nominated to the Triple Crown.

**SUFFOLK DOWNS EXPANDS SIMULCASTING** For the first time, Suffolk Downs in East Boston, Massachusetts will simulcast its races to New York, Pennsylvania and New Orleans. Beginning with today's card, the races from Suffolk will be available to the New York State, Pennsylvania and New Orleans off-track betting networks in a common-pool format. The New England track altered its takeout structure on daily doubles and exactas from 26 to 25 percent to accommodate the common-pool arrangement in New York.
