## DEHERE COLICS; OUT OF HUTCHESON

According to John Perrotta, general manager of Due Process Stable, last year's champion two-year-old **Dehere** (Deputy Minister) suffered a bout with colic and has been scratched from today's Hutcheson S. at Gulfstream Park. Said owner Bob Brennan, "Our goal since Oct. was to run in the Hutcheson and I am sorry that now it is not possible. However, Reynaldo (trainer Nobles) told me the colt is dead fit and will proceed toward our primary goal of the winter, the Florida Derby, preceded by the Fountain of Youth."

## LAUREL CANCELS AGAIN; PHILADELPHIA RETURNS TO ACTION TODAY

Laurel Race Course canceled its live racing card Saturday due to unsafe track conditions created by Friday's ice storm. Simulcast wagering from Gulfstream, the Fair Grounds, Santa Anita and Freehold was offered, and the Maryland track will attempt to resume live racing Sunday. Philadelphia Park will also try to get back in action today; to date, the track has managed to complete only five live racing cards in 1994, most recently Jan. 11. Because the severe weather has disrupted training schedules as well, nine of the 10 races carded at Philadelphia Sunday are sprints, including a quarter-mile event for claiming fillies and mares--a field of 12 is entered.

## BULL IN THE HEATHER READIES FOR RETURN

Four-year-old **Bull In the Heather** (Ferdinand), winner of the '93 GI Florida Derby, could make his return to the races Tuesday at Gulfstream. The colt is listed as also eligible in a mile-and-a-sixteenth turf allowance; he has not raced since finishing eighth in the Belmont Stakes last June.

### Thoro-Graph Analysis

Sunday's Hutcheson, despite the defection of Dehere, remains one of the best three-year-old races ever to be run this early in the year. Let me go on record as being the first to say that this year's crop is the best in many years, since at least the days of Easy Goer and Sunday Silence.

**Patton** (Lord At War) has shown promise since his debut at Calder and his last figure was enormous, in part because he lost so much ground on the turn. At the weights, a repeat would win this easily--but this looks like a case of too much, too soon and Patton figures to bounce.

**Holy Bull** (Great Above) probably deserved the Eclipse Award; he was an undefeated Grade I winner and beat Dehere head to head. From a figure point of view, he's at the exact same level as Dehere--which is to say he's a nice horse, but unless he improves he's not the fastest horse in the race.

The bet in the Hutcheson is **You and I** (Kris S.), who ran huge figures in both his starts as a juvenile. His three-year-old debut was also much better than it looked--he was spotting seven pounds (two lengths) to the runner-up and beat the rest of the field by 13 lengths.

Third finisher that day was **Crary** (Mt. Livermore), who may not have liked the off track. Getting a big break in the weights today, he may jump up with a big one and since he will be a price, we will use him in exactas with You and I. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many horsemen and professional handicappers to evaluate the ability of racehorses. **CHBPA REVIEW COMPLETE** After reviewing five years of financial statements from the California division of the HBPA, the California Horse Racing Board moved Friday to place certain restrictions and conditions on the CHBPA's expenditures of statutorily mandated funds. CHR Commissioner James Watson suggested that the CHBPA be prohibited from contributing any such funds to political candidates, and that it limit its lobbying efforts to no more than 5 percent of its budget--and only on issues directly involving or impacting horsemen. Also, any CHBPA commitment in excess of \$1,000 should be written up in contract form and approved by its directors. The financial statements reviewed by the board included actual operating data for 1990 through 1993 and projected figures for 1994. Watson, who conducted the review, noted that revenue for those years has remained relatively constant at about \$2.2 million annually, but expenditures have increased dramatically during the same period. On another issue, the Board asked the CHBPA to amend its bylaws to require that 12 of the organization's 18 directors be owners, in recognition of the greater number of owners who belong to the horsemen's group. The CHBPA should hold an election for all 18 directors by June 24, 1994. The Board also authorized the use of the "Quick Official" on a trial basis Feb. 2-July 25.
