GULFSTREAM PURSES RAISED AGAIN

All Gulfstream Park overnight purses will be increased by \$1,000 effective Feb. 2, announced track President and CEO Douglas Donn yesterday. The increases will run through the meet's closing day March 16. Overnight purses were previously boosted by 15 percent over the initial allocation.

FLORIDA TRACKS TO PARTICIPATE IN CASINO CAMPAIGN

A campaign to legalize casino gambling in the state of Florida is being planned through a political action committee called Proposition for Limited Casinos. The committee, which is reportedly comprised of Florida's thoroughbred and greyhound racetracks, jai-alai operators, cruise lines, hotels and gaming companies, hopes to place the question of legalized casino gambling in Florida on the Nov. 8 Election Day ballot.

BAY MEADOWS WRAP-UP

Bay Meadows concluded its 1993-4, 105-day meet Sat. Total on-track attendance was down 5.82 percent from the 1992-3 meet, and daily average on-track attendance was down 2.24 percent. Total on-track handle decreased 5.72 percent from last year's figures and daily average on-track handle dropped 2.13 percent. However, total handle, including simulcasting revenues, increased 4.55 percent from the 1992-3 meet. Average daily handle, including simulcasting, which numbered \$2,403,072 last year, rose to \$2,608,049, an 8.53 percent increase. Russell Baze took his 11th Bay Meadows riding title with 162 victories. Jerry Hollendorfer, the winningest trainer in the track's history, saddled 63 winners to secure his eighth straight training title. **Slew of Damascus** (Slewacide), winner of the GII Bay Meadows H., GIII Tanforan H. and GIII William P. Kyne H., was named "Horse of the Meeting."

Undefeated Holy Bull, now 5 for 5 including 3 stakes wins, went to the front at the start, then was headed in the stretch by Patton before coming back to prevail by 3/4 of a length. Trainer Warren Croll Jr. said of the 1-2 favorite, "He was right on edge coming up to this race. If he hadn't run today, he would have exploded." Holy Bull's jockey Mike Smith said, "I know I must have scared a lot of people when I came off the rail and that other horse came inside of me. But I knew I had a lot of horse under me and that I could take the lead back when I wanted it. I never hit him and he was going away at the end." Trainer Sonny Hine said of 2nd-place finisher Patton, "He ran a hell of a race. He just got beat by a better horse." The time of the race, 1:21 1/5, was the fastest Hutcheson since Gay Jitterbug's 1:21 in 1976.

CASH ASMUSSEN TO REMAIN IN FRANCE

Jockey Cash Asmussen will not be riding full-time for Englishman David Hill in Hong Kong next winter. Asmussen and Hill had been trying to negotiate a contract, but the jockey's commitments in France have proved a barrier to any agreement between them. Hill said, "Cash could not be here in Hong Kong until next Jan. and, if I have a regular jockey, he would need to be available from mid-October." The trainer has now advised Asmussen to apply to the Royal Hong Kong Jockey Club for an international license, which will enable him to ride in the colony on a short-term basis.
