TRA APPROVES NATIONAL WAGER

A weekly national bet, based on a pick-7 format with a base wager of 50 cents, was approved yesterday by the Board of Directors of the Thoroughbred Racing Associations. The bet will be offered in racing jurisdictions across the country, based on stakes races and high quality allowance races at tracks throughout North America. The bet will be offered each Sat. and has a scheduled start-up of Spring of 1994. Estimated weekly wagering is approximately \$500,000. Betting will be into a single national pool with a planned standardized takeout rate of 25 percent. The payoff format includes three components: a win pool consisting of 63 percent of the net paid to perfect ticket holders, a Jackpot consisting of 7 percent of the net paid only in the event of a single perfect winning ticket, and a consolation consisting of 30 percent of the net. Both the win pool and the Jackpot will carry over each week should there be no winner. "Additional details of the national wager will be forthcoming," said TRA Commissioner Brian McGrath. "While there are legal, regulatory and logistical details to be worked through, we are pointing toward the Triple Crown season when national interest in Thoroughbred racing is at its highest."

HORSE ISOLATED AT AQUEDUCT

"As of this afternoon we have found fever in one horse stabled at Aqueduct and are in the process of isolating that horse," said NYRA veterinarian Dr. Theodore Hill yesterday, only three days after several horses at Belmont were diagnosed with preliminary signs of equine viral rhino-pneumonitis. "This move is purely precautionary, but under the circumstances we felt it necessary," Hill said. "We will continue to monitor Aqueduct very closely and that horse's barn in particular. Again to stress, though preliminary test results are consistent with rhino-pneumonitis, confirmation of that virus is still pending."

TRIPLE CROWN NOMINEES ARE ANNOUNCED

A total of 354 three-year-olds, headed by 1993 Eclipse Award-winning juvenile **Dehere** (Deputy Minister) and Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Brocco** (Kris S.), have been nominated to the 1994 running of the Chrysler Triple Crown Challenge. This year's total surpasses by 12 last year's early nomination total of 342. The Challenge guarantees \$5 million to any winner of all three Triple Crown races. Among the nominees are 17 from overseas- 16 from Europe and one now racing in Dubai. **Fappiano** and **Seeking the Gold** led all sires in number of nominees, with nine each. D. Wayne Lukas nominated 12 horses, more than any other trainer. Dogwood Stable led all owners with eight early nominees. Six of those nominated are fillies, including 1993 GI winners **Heavenly Prize** (Seeking the Gold), **Sardula** (Storm Cat) and **Strategic Maneuver** (Cryptoclearance). This marks the ninth straight year that Chrysler Corporation and Triple Crown Productions will offer the \$5 million Challenge.

KELLNER AUTHORS CHILI COOKBOOK

Jenny Kellner, president of the National Turf Writers Association, has signed a contract to co-author "The All New Official International Chili Society Cookbook," due to be published in the fall of '94. Jockey Julie Krone, NYRA track announcer Tom Durkin and Thoroughbred owner Edith Libutti are among those who've agreed to submit recipes. Kellner has co-organized an NYTWA-sponsored chili cookoff at Saratoga for the past two years to aid racing-related charities.
