**ARCANGUES OUT OF BIG 'CAP** Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Arcangues** (Sagace) will not make his '94 debut in the Santa Anita H., trainer Richard Mandella said yesterday morning. "He bruised his foot last week and it will cost him enough time to miss the race. There was some heat in (the right front hoof) and we were on a tight schedule to make it as it was. We had no time to back off, and now we have to," said Mandella.

**MCCARRON FRACTURES HAND** Jockey Chris McCarron suffered a slight fracture of his right hand when Falcon Bid fell at the quarter pole in Saturday's third race at Santa Anita. McCarron returned from the spill to ride back-to-back winners in the sixth and seventh races, but x-rays Sunday morning revealed a slight fracture. McCarron missed only his mount in yesterday's first race, and was back in the saddle to finish fourth aboard Zignew in the Strub S.

**SANTA MARIA NEXT FOR SENSATIONAL EYES?** **Sensational Eyes** (Roman Majesty) was scratched from Saturday's La Canada S. at Santa Anita due to an abcess in her left hind foot, but she was back on the track Sunday morning for a six-furlong breeze in 1:13 3/5. "She galloped (Saturday) and she came back raw," said trainer Gary Jones. "I had an aluminum plate on there. She galloped great but she came back bleeding. The abcess is in a place where there's no way she can avoid concussion." Added assistant Rafael Becerra about the breeze, "She looked as good as new. We did some work on her since (Saturday) and she had on new shoes and seems to be much better." The filly is possible to make the Santa Maria H. at Santa Anita Saturday.

After riding seven winners of the Strub, Bill Shoemaker returned to the winner's circle as the trainer of the '94 victor, DIAZO. Under jockey Laffit Pincay Jr., the 6-1 shot made his bid from midfield on the far turn and lasted to win the photo over a fast-closing Nonproductiveasset to pay \$14.60. "It's a great feeling--I never felt this good when I rode those seven winners as I do today," said Shoemaker. Favored Kissin Kris was never a factor; said jockey Jerry Bailey, "Turning for home, I had nowhere to go and although I didn't really have to pull him up, I had to steady him a bit. Once he lost his stride, I couldn't get him going again." Fourth-place finisher Zignew pulled up lame after the race with a possible fractured left cannon bone, but the injury did not appear to be life-threatening.

### ON TAP AT • GULFSTREAM

Icy Warning--best known for beating eventual Kentucky Derby winner Sea Hero in her last visit--returns to Gulfstream Park Wednesday. Trainer Mark Hennig said Icy Warning will be pointed for the \$75,000 Suwanee River (Grade III) on the turf over one mile and an eighth Feb. 16. "She's doing pretty well," says Hennig. She has been knocking heads with some nice fillies. Last year, she showed a definite liking for the turf course at Gulfstream. Sprinter Demaloot Demashoot may also be shipped from Hollywood Park with the filly. "He's been training great," said Hennig. Demaloot Demashoot finished fifth in the Breeders' Cup Sprint (Grade I) and has not yet made his 1994 debut.
