**MORE RACING CANCELLATIONS** Dangerous roadways and freezing temperatures forced Garden State Park to cancel its Thurs. night card, marking the 10th time this year the track has cancelled. Thurs. racing was also called off at Turfway Park and Oaklawn.

**BROCCO 50-50 FOR SAN RAFAEL** Trainer Randy Winick said yesterday that Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Brocco** (Kris S.) is only 50-50 to make the \$150,000a San Rafael S. at Santa Anita March 6 due to weather-related setbacks in his training schedule. "He tied up pretty good behind after his last work, too, and he was pretty stiff," said Winick. "It's nothing serious. He's just eager and anxious. The rain cost us some time and I had to ease off, but he's been galloping for 10 days and he's scheduled to breeze (Friday)." If Brocco doesn't make the San Rafael, the San Felipe two weeks later would be Winick's first option.

**LOBLOLLY HORSES BACK ON TRACK** Two of Loblolly Stable's top runners from last year are back on track. Last year's Remington Park Derby winner **Marked Tree** (Forty Niner) will make his return in today's feature at Oaklawn, a one-mile allowance test. It is his first start since finishing off the board in the Peter Pan S. at Belmont last May. **Dalhart** (Forty Niner), winner of the '93 Rebel S. at Oaklawn, worked a half mile in a bullet :47 4/5 at the Arkansas oval Sunday as he prepares for his first race since he was ninth as the odds-on favorite in last year's Arkansas Derby. "I want to work him a couple more times," said trainer Tom Bohannon. "He's training real well, but I haven't made a decision yet on when he might return to the races. It will be an allowance race."
