HOLLYWOOD PARK ANNOUNCES STAKES

SCHEDULE Hollywood Park has announced a schedule of 35 stakes worth a total of \$5.9 million for its 1994 spring/summer meet, April 27-July 25. The stakes schedule is highlighted by the \$750,000 Hollywood Gold Cup (July 2) and the \$500,000 Hollywood Turf H. (May 30). There are 31 graded stakes in all. The stakes program opens April 29, the first of 13 Friday night cards, with the \$100,000a Gil A Gleam H., a seven-furlong test for fillies and mares. In other stakes news from the California oval, Racing Secretary Eual Wyatt Jr. announced the addition of a one-mile event to the Autumn Turf Festival this fall, the \$150,000 Hollywood Mile. The Gil Citation H., also a part of the Festival, will be stretched a furlong to a mile and a quarter.

PIGGOTT TAKES HONG KONG TRIAL Lester Piggott stole the show at Sha Tin Racecourse Friday when he rode four-year-old **Sterling Town** to a short head victory in the one-mile Hong Kong Classic Trial. Riding in Hong Kong for the first time this year, Piggott squeezed his mount through a narrow gap on the rail to take the HK \$1.35 million prize in the final strides. Trained by Ivan Allan, Sterling Town will now be aimed for the Hong Kong Derby.

SARDULA TO SKIP LAS VIRGENES Sardula (Storm Cat), runner-up in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and winner of the GI Hollywood Starlet, will pass the GI Las Virgenes at Santa Anita next Sunday, according to trainer Brian Mayberry. "It's a long year," said Mayberry, who added that the filly would now be pointed for the Santa Anita Oaks March 13. Trainer Neil Drysdale, however, has confirmed that the talented **Princess Mitterand** (Seattle Slew) will go in the Las Virgenes.

Three noses separated the first three finishers as Supah Gem led from flagfall to finish to get the bob and pay \$13.40 under jockey Corey Nakatani. Odds-on favorite Paseana returned from a three-month layoff to just miss. "I thought I had lost from where I was," said Supah Gem's trainer, Wally Dollase. "Corey did a beautiful job--I can't believe we beat Paseana. Paseana ran a terrific race after that long layoff." Trainer Ron McAnally said of the runner-up, "The race will do her good. If things are all right, the Santa Margarita (March 6) will be next."

ON TAP AT • GULFSTREAM

Overbrook Farm's Blacksburg, who recently set a record of 1:39 for a mile and seventy yards at Gulfstream Park; C.B. Farm's Conveyer, a sharp winner at the meeting; and 33 others have been named for the \$150,000 Gulfstream Park Budweiser Breeders' Cup Handicap (Grade II). The event, at a mile and three furlongs on the turf, will be run Sunday, Feb. 20.

It was also announced by Gulfstream Racing Secretary Robert Umphrey that 40 fillies and mares have been named for the \$75,000 Suwanee River Handicap (Grade III). That event, at a mile and a furlong over the turf, is set for Wednesday, Feb. 16.
