**NEW YORK VIRUS OUTBREAK UNDER CONTROL** The outbreak of equine rhino-pneumonitis at Belmont Park, which was confirmed by test results last week, seems to be under control and the ban on shipping to and from NYRA tracks may be lifted as early as midweek. "If it's still quiet, we may be able to lift the restrictions by the middle of the week," said Dr. Ted Hill, NYRA's chief veterinarian, who reported that there have been no new cases of the disease. Of the horses now isolated at Belmont, Hill said, "They're all looking pretty good now. Hopefully they'll be out of quarantine by midweek, if there are no new cases. That will take us to two weeks (in quarantine)."

**CARDMANIA TO UNDERGO SURGERY** Sprint champion **Cardmania** (Cox's Ridge), who suffered a fractured cannon bone in his left hind leg Friday, has been shipped to the Alamo Pintado equine facility in Solvang, California and was scheduled for surgery yesterday. The six-year-old was getting ready to try nine furlongs in yesterday's San Antonio H. at Santa Anita before he was injured during his gallop Friday morning.

**JEFF LUKAS MAY LEAVE HOSPITAL WITHIN A MONTH** Trainer Jeff Lukas, who has been recovering from multiple skull fractures at Huntington Memorial Hospital in Pasadena since Dec. 15, might be out of the hospital in "three to four weeks", according to his father, D. Wayne Lukas. "From there he would go to the rehabilitation center at Casa Colina," he said. "We're very pleased with his progress, but he still has a long way to go. He is participating in both physical and group therapy four hours a day, and he is walking with the aid of a walker."
