NJ RACING COMMISSION LIFTS BAN ON SHIPPERS The New Jersey Racing Commission has lifted its ban against horses stabled at nearby tracks shipping into Garden State Park for races. The Commission had issued a directive Feb. 4 placing an embargo on horses from nearby tracks because of an outbreak of equine herpes at a riding academy near Aqueduct. The directive was rescinded only after a series of investigations and tests produced no evidence of the virus at either Garden State or the embargoed tracks. The first evidence of the lifting of the ban will be on Fri. night's card, when shippers from Philadelphia Park, Penn National, Belmont, Aqueduct and Delaware Park, for the first time in two weeks, will be able to head for the starting gate.

McCARRON/DEHERE REUNION POSTPONED For the second time in a row, jockey Chris McCarron will miss an opportunity to ride last year's Eclipse Award winner **Dehere** (Deputy Minister). McCarron begins serving a five-day suspension at Santa Anita Sat., Feb. 19, which will make him ineligible to ride Dehere in Gulfstream's GII Fountain of Youth this Sat. Earlier in the month, McCarron served a five-day suspension and missed Dehere's three-year-old debut Feb. 5, when the colt ran second to **Ride the Rails** (Cryptoclearance). Craig Perret is expected to pick up the mount on Dehere.

PURSES INCREASE AT ROYAL ASCOT Purses at this year's Royal Ascot meeting will total more than 1.4 million pounds, an increase of 6.5 percent over last season's figure. Ascot's three Group 1 events, The Gold Cup, St. James's Palace and Coronation S., will each receive an extra 5,000 pounds in purse money, making the overall value of each nearly 150,000 pounds, excluding owners' contributions.

Then they'll X-ray him again and re-evaluate his status."

NEW TRAINER FOR KISSIN KRIS Kissin Kris (Kris S.), sixth in the Feb. 6 Strub S. at Santa Anita after shipping to Southern California from trainer David Bell's Gulfstream headquarters, had been temporarily stabled at Jack Van Berg's Hollywood Park barn. Van Berg's barn has now become Kissin Kris' permanent home, as 1993 Eclipse Award-winning owner John Franks has decided on a change of trainers for the four-year-old.
