REPORT ON CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING

RELEASED A study released yesterday by the California Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association concluded that the horse racing industry has a major impact on the economy of California, creating 28,200 full-time equivalent jobs and \$1.65 billion in total expenditures during 1992. The study, prepared by Thalheimer Research Associates of Lexington, Kentucky, measured racing's effect in 1992 on jobs, revenue and taxes, among other areas. The study found that in 1992, total federal, state and local taxes generated by the industry were estimated to be \$246.4 million. The Thoroughbred sector of the industry paid a high percentage of that tax; in '92, the share of wagering which went to the government from Thoroughbred race meets was 25.4 percent, almost twice that of non-Thoroughbred meets (13 percent). Research consisted of random samples of California race horses by breed, including Thoroughbred, Quarter Horse, Standardbred, Appaloosa and Arabian. Said CHBPA President Chris Clark, "We need to have this kind of study to take to Sacramento, to show the legislature how important this industry is to the overall state of the economy."

QUEST FOR FAME'S FIRST FOAL Quest For Fame (Rainbow Quest), a GI winner in England and North America and winner of \$1.8 million, became a father for the first time yesterday when **Prospect Digger** (Mr. Prospector) produced his first foal. The filly was born at Airdrie Stud in Midway, Kentucky; Quest For Fame, the 1990 Epsom Derby victor, stands at Gainesway Farm in Lexington.

The journey to the Triple Crown begins in earnest with the much-awaited rematch of **Holy Bull** (Great Above) and **Dehere** (Deputy Minister), but the pair may not meet if Mother Nature doesn't cooperate. The undefeated Holy Bull was made the early favorite at 9-5; the grey had his final work for the race yesterday at Gulfstream, going a half-mile in :49 over a sloppy track. "It is a pleasure to have a horse like this," said trainer Jimmy Croll. "Most trainers are praying for rain or praying it won't rain; my horse will run on anything." Dehere had been scheduled to breeze at Palm Beach Downs, but did not train due to the track condition; trainer Reynaldo Nobles has said he will scratch the champion if the track is muddy or sloppy Saturday. "I don't think Dehere likes the mud," he said. "I have to give him the best of it. If this were the Kentucky Derby, I would have to run. This is just the beginning. It is still early in the year." MAKE THAT A DOUBLE FOR BENGAL BAY

Barry Abrams, a former standardbred trainer, is giving serious consideration to running **Bengal Bay** (Woodman) twice this weekend--the five-year-old will be entered in both the five-and-a-half furlong El Conejo H. on the dirt Saturday and the mile-and-a-half San Luis Obispo H. on the Santa Anita turf Monday. Abrams ran the Kentucky-bred three times in nine days in Dec.; he was fourth Dec. 11 and 15, and won Dec. 19. Bengal Bay won his last two starts, which were only a week apart, Jan. 30 and Feb. 5. "He's a big, strong horse and it's not going to bother him," said the trainer. "But I'm not going to run just to get a check. I'm running to win."

GRAND NATIONAL FAVORITE WINS Double Silk (Dubassoff), one of the early favorites for the '94 Grand National, put on a devastating performance at Sandown Thursday, winning a two-and-a-half mile steeplechase by 25 lengths. Owner/trainer Reg Wilkins had considered starting the jumper in the Cheltenham Gold Cup before the Grand National, but has decided instead to point him for the Foxhunters' Chase, a race he won last year. "The Gold Cup might take the edge off him and I want him spot on for Aintree," said Wilkins, whose 'chaser is now top price at 9-1 for the April 9 Grand National. Double Silk will make his next start at Warwick March 3.
