PINCAY INJURED IN SANTA ANITA

SPILL Hall of Fame jockey Laffit Pincay Jr. was injured in a spill at Santa Anita yesterday when his mount in the featured El Conejo S., Arrowtown, collided with Prince Wild, who broke down as the field came into the stretch. Pincay lay motionless for several minutes after the fall, but he remained conscious. He was taken to Arcadia Methodist Hospital for treatment of a possible concussion and observation. According to track veterinarian Ray Baran, Arrowtown suffered a broken neck and died instantly; Prince Wild ruptured the distal ligaments below the sesamoids in his right fore and was vanned back to trainer Jack Van Berg's barn.

NEW YORK RETURNS TO NINE-RACE

WEEKEND SCHEDULE The New York Racing Association announced yesterday that it will return to a schedule of nine live races each Saturday and Sunday as of this weekend. In addition, there will be at least five races simulcast from Gulfstream Park Saturdays and Sundays; some weekends will be expanded to include special events. The decision was made to make up for some of the races lost due to the bad weather this winter.

She tries two turns for the first time, but with adequate rest, excellent works and a pedigree that won't quit, we like her chances.
