PINCAY ESCAPES SERIOUS INJURY Laffit Pincay Jr., who was taken to Arcadia Methodist Hospital following a spill in Saturday's feature race at Santa Anita, was treated and released. "I'm pretty sore today," said the 47-year-old Hall of Famer Sunday morning from his home. "Last night I thought it might be something in my spinal column, because my back was sore. But today it's the area around my shoulder blade. If it doesn't feel better (Monday) morning, I'll go see Dr. (Robert) Kerlan." Pincay's mount in the race, Arrowtown, broke his neck in the spill and died on the track; Prince Wild, whose breakdown caused the incident, suffered ligament damage to his right foreleg and will not race again, but he will be saved for possible stud duty.

HOLY BULL, HALO'S IMAGE OKAY AFTER DISAPPOINTING IN FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH Holy Bull (Great Above) and Halo's Image (Halo) vied for the lead early in Saturday's Fountain of Youth S., but favored Holy Bull stopped badly on the turn to finish last; Halo's Image inherited the lead but bolted as the field came into the stretch and finished near the outside rail. But their respective trainers could find no physical problems. "He came back fine," said trainer Jimmy Croll of Holy Bull. "(Mike Smith) thought he might have bled and eased him up; fortunately he didn't. He probably flipped his palate. That seems to be the most logical explanation." Pierre Bellocq, assistant to trainer Happy Alter, said of Halo's Image, "It seems to have been a mental thing. That was the first time he was alone in front. It seems to have come into his mind to make a right turn at the wrong spot." Both colts are still considered possible for the March 12 Florida Derby.

Undefeated Lakeway overcame a bump at the start, moving to the lead at the top of the stretch and drawing off to win under jockey Kent Desormeaux; the odds-on choice paid \$3.80. "I'm happy for her owner and breeder (Mike Rutherford)," said trainer Gary Jones. "He's a guy that deserves good luck. I watched the track condition all day long and I must have talked to Mike about nine times on whether to run. They've done a great job with the track. It was in good shape, so we went ahead and got the job done." Now three-for-three, the filly will run next in the Santa Anita Oaks (March 13), and is also expected to head east for the Kentucky Oaks (May 6).

Santa Anita reported 1.1 inches of rain Saturday night into Sunday morning, a major cause of concern for trainer Paco Gonzalez, who has **Bien Bien** (Manila) in today's featured race. "If it's still like this, I won't run him," he said Sunday. "If he doesn't make this, we'll look at the Santa Anita H." Longshot **Bengal Bay** (Woodman), fourth in Saturday's El Conejo at five-and-a-half furlongs, will wheel right back today. "The horse is in good shape and he only ran a half-mile (Saturday)," said trainer Barry Abrams. But, just in case plans change, the horse is entered back for Wednesday; he won't run both days.

1993 SANTA ANITA H. WINNER DIES IN CALIFORNIA Sir Beaufort (Pleasant Colony), winner of the 1993 Santa Anita H., died Sunday of a ruptured intestine. He was on the farm in Bradbury, California and was scheduled to ship to Arthur Hancock's Stone Farm in Paris, Kentucky today to begin his stud career. "It was a freak thing. He'd never been sick a day in his life," said his trainer, Charlie Whittingham.

MINER'S MARK READIES FOR RETURN

Miner's Mark (Mr. Prospector), winner of the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup last year, worked a half-mile in :53 2/5 at Payson Park Sunday as he prepares for his first race since finishing 12th in the Breeders' Cup Classic. Trainer Shug McGaughey said the four-year-old is three to four weeks from a race, and will probably run in a Gulfstream allowance before the meet is over.

CALIFORNIA STAKES FRONT Slew of Damascus

(Slewacide), who was scratched from last Sunday's San Antonio H. after he broke through the starting gate, dropped jockey Pat Valenzuela and ran off, may make his next start in the GI Santa Anita H. March 5. "If I can get the work into him that I want, then I'd say there's an excellent chance we'll run," said trainer Craig Roberts from his barn at Bay Meadows Saturday. In other California stakes news, trainer Ron McAnally said he will skip the San Rafael S. with Hollywood Futurity winner **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty) and run stablemate **Fumo di Londra** (Indian Ridge {IRE}); Valiant Nature will wait for the San Felipe S. March 20. Santa Catalina S. victor **Wekiva Springs** (Runaway Groom) suffered a minor injury during training Friday, but is still pointing for the San Rafael. "He grazed his right front quarter and will miss four or five days," said trainer Bob Hess Jr. "It's very minor; he is sound and still expected to make the San Rafael."
