**ENGLAND'S ALL-WEATHER JUMP RACING SUSPENDED** All-weather jump racing in England has been suspended for the rest of the season to allow detailed investigation into the safety of the sport. The decision, reached late Thursday night by the British Horseracing Board, came within hours of the death of War Beat on Lingfield's Equitrack. It was the 13th fatality in an all-weather hurdle race since the beginning of the season. Said the horse's owner, Ian Baugh, "I think War Beat would have survived the fall on grass, but there is no give in the surface on these all-weather tracks." War Beat was six lengths in front when he fell at the final obstacle. Said BHB's Chief Executive Tristram Ricketts, "There is prima facie evidence that we are exposing people and horses to unnecessary risks. In no sense are we saying that this is the demise of this particular type of racing, but we do need time for cool, calm reflection."

**GULFSTREAM ESTABLISHES FUND FOR INJURED RIDER** Employees of Gulfstream Park have established a trust fund for Mary Rafferty, the exercise rider who was seriously injured in a spill at Gulfstream last Monday. Rafferty remains in critical condition in the intensive care unit of Hollywood's Memorial Hospital with a fractured back. The Mary Rafferty Benefit Fund has been opened at the Family Bank of Hallandale, and the initial contribution was made by Gulfstream Park. Contributions can be sent to Mark Gunderson, secretary-treasurer of Gulfstream, 901 South Federal Hwy., Hallandale, Florida, 33009.

**LONE STAR PARK NAMES VP/GENERAL MANAGER** Corey Johnson, currently general manager of Remington Park, yesterday was named vice president and general manager of Grand Prairie's Lone Star Park in Texas. The 39-year-old has been with Remington since 1988, and won an Eclipse Award for local television production in 1986.

**CHRB TO EXPAND AUTHORITY** The California Horse Racing Board Friday endorsed the concept of expanding its authority to include the regulation of card clubs and all other forms of legal gaming in the state except the lottery. Bill SB 362, currently before the Senate Governmental Organization Committee, would grant the CHRB greater regulatory powers in gaming. The Board stopped short of fully endorsing the bill. "I suggest that for now we simply endorse the concept, then follow the bill as it goes through the process and give testimony where necessary," said Chairman Ralph Scurfield.
