### ABC TO TELEVISION SANTA ANITA HANDICAP

The Santa Anita H., set for Saturday, March 5, will be telecast on ABC's "Wide World of Sports." Post time is scheduled for 2:46 p.m. PST; the race will be shown live in the east and on tape delay in the west. The probable field for the GI, \$1,000,000 event is: Kissin Kris (Kris S.), Hill Pass (Temperence Hill), Region (Devil's Bag), The Wicked North (Far North), Nonproductiveasset (Stalwart), Diazo (Jade Hunter), Stuka (Jade Hunter) and Myrakalu (Kaldoun {FR}). Also possible are Slew of Damascus (Slewacide), Megan's Interco (Interco), and Bien Bien (Manila). Strub Stakes winner Diazo will have his final breeze for the race this morning; Slew of Damascus, The Wicked North, Nonproductiveasset, Region and Myrakalu will work Monday.

Donald Brumfield will give up jockey Earlie Fires' book after the Gulfstream Park meet to serve as a steward at the new Sam Houston Race Track in Texas. Brumfield was a steward at Hialeah in 1989. Agent Stoney McLaughlin will pick up Fires' book after Gulfstream when the rider heads to Keeneland.

Coming off a second-place finish in the GIII Sabin H. at GP, NINE KEYS sat just off the pace early, then took over the lead from odds-on favorite Educated Risk and drove to victory under jockey Mike Smith. The second choice paid \$8.80 for her fifth win from just eight career starts. Never off the board, her record improves to 8-5-2-1, earnings up to \$223,810. Runner-up Educated Risk, also on the board in every start, moved from second to the lead at the top of the stretch, but couldn't hold off the winner.
