FLORIDA Mary Rafferty, the exercise rider who was involved in a spill at Gulfstream Park during training hours last Monday, died Saturday at Hollywood Memorial Hospital without regaining consciousness. She was 41. Funeral arrangements have not been finalized.

SUPER FIT TAKES HONG KONG DERBY

New Zealand-bred **Super Fit** (Centaine {AUS}), ridden by the French jockey Gerald Mosse and trained by Lawrie Fownes, took yesterday's Hong Kong Derby at Sha-Tin Racecourse. The four-year-old gelding had finished off the board in the Hong Kong Classic Trial last time out. New Zealand-breds took the top three spots in the race, worth approximately \$700,000, with **All Thrills** (Straight Strike) taking the place and **Our Pal** (Bakharoff) getting the show.

HOLY BULL WORKS AT GULFSTREAM

Holy Bull (Great Above) worked seven furlongs in 1:23 under jockey Mike Smith yesterday morning, prompting trainer Jimmy Croll to give the green light for a run in the GI Florida Derby March 12. "I thought he had an excuse last time out and this work proved to me that I was right. He got stirred up (in the Fountain of Youth); he flipped his palate and couldn't get his air," said Croll.

THIRD PURSE RAISE FOR FAIR GROUNDS

For the third time in 10 days, Fair Grounds has announced an increase in purses. Effective Wednesday, March 2, the value of 11 stakes will go up, and there will be an across-the-board increase in overnight purses as well. Topping the list of stakes purses to be augmented are the GIII Fair Grounds Oaks, up to \$150,000-added, and the Explosive Bid S. on the turf, raised to \$125,000-added. Overnight purses will increase \$500 to \$1,500 in value.

Under Eddie Delahoussaye, the winner paid \$22.80 in her first start in three months. "She's been training super and the time off seemed to help her," said trainer Mark Hennig. "We were going to try and breed this filly sometime late in the spring, but this might push it back a little bit." Favored Possibly Perfect fought for the lead until deep in the stretch but faded to fourth in the final strides. "She sure ran tough for not having any shoes," said her jockey, Kent Desormeaux. "She blew them early; I'm not sure exactly where. She was stumbling around on the first turn."

PARTY CITED RETIRED Stakes winner **Party Cited** (Alleged), owned by Bull Market Stable and Gary Tanaka, has been retired and will be bred this spring, trainer Rodney Rash reported Sunday. "She just has a minor injury. She was a fine mare and we're sorry to lose her, but are looking forward to her offspring. I don't know where we'll send her yet," Rash said. The five-year-old Kentucky-bred won five of her 24 starts, including the Gill Yerba Buena at Golden Gate and the Bayakoa H. at Del Mar in 1993, and \$377,943; she closed her career with a second in an allowance event at Santa Anita Jan. 27.

BRITAIN INVADES AMERICA AGAIN Trainer Clive Brittain, who brought Bold Arrangement over from England to finish a narrow second to Ferdinand in the 1986 Kentucky Derby, has announced that he will point the French-bred colt **Cedez Le Passage** (Warning {GB}) to the "Run for the Roses" this year. The bay, who, like Bold Arrangement is owned by Tony Richards, made his second career start last Friday at the all-weather Fibresand track at Southwell in England and won the one-mile Claypole Maiden S. by two-and-a-half lengths. His next stop on the road to Churchill Downs is expected to be the Doncaster Mile at the end of March.

PASEANA WORKS FOR SANTA MARGARITA Two-time champion **Paseana** (Ahmad), nosed out in the GI Santa Maria H. in her '94 debut Feb. 12, breezed six furlongs Sunday at Santa Anita in preparation for next Sunday's Santa Margarita H. The seven-year-old went the distance in 1:12 3/5. Also working yesterday at the Arcadia, California oval: GI Las Virgenes winner **Lakeway** (Seattle Slew) went a half mile in :49 3/5 pointing for the Santa Anita Oaks; and Breeders' Cup Classic victor **Arcangues** (Sagace) went the same distance in :51 4/5.

BIG 'CAP RUNNERS BREEZE Strub Stakes winner **Diazo** (Jade Hunter) went a mile on the Santa Anita main track Sunday morning, readying for a possible start in Saturday's \$1,000,000 Santa Anita H. Under jockey Laffit Pincay Jr., the four-year-old Allen Paulson colorbearer got the distance in a moderate 1:44 2/5. Claiborne Farm's **Region** (Devil's Bag) also prepped for the Big 'Cap yesterday, going six furlongs in 1:11 4/5 with Eddie Delahoussaye up. "Super; he galloped out seven-eighths in 1:25," said trainer Dick Mandella. The status of **Megan's Interco** (Interco) is still up in the air, but the nominee went a brisk five furlongs in :58 3/5 Sunday morning with jockey Corey Black aboard. "We'll play it by ear, look at the weights and see who's in the race," said trainer Jenine Sahadi, who is also considering the one-mile Arcadia H. on the turf for her charge.
