### SOUTH FLORIDA DATES WAR CONTINUES

The South Florida dates war that raged for the past 47 years moved into its 48th year Tues., March 1. Representative Rudy Garcia (R-Hialeah) helped to introduce and pass a bill in the House Regulated Industries Committee, calling for Gulfstream Park and Hialeah to rotate a 60-day race meeting every other year. The bill, which passed by a 15 to 7 margin, caught both Gulfstream and Calder lobbyists off guard. The bill will proceed to the House Finance and Taxation Committee, where Luis Rojas (R-Hialeah) is expected to move it along.

### FASIG-TIPTON FLORIDA RESULTS

The second and final day of the Fasig-Tipton Florida Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale was led by session-topper **Brisco County**, a bay colt by Ogygian-Carter's Creek (Coastal). Consigned by The Kindergarten, agent, Brisco County was purchased for \$250,000 by Dr. John R.S. Fisher, agent. During the sale's two sessions, 187 hips were sold for a gross of \$13,353,000 and an average of \$71,406. This represents a 9.3 percent increase over last year's selected session, when 154 hips were sold for an average of \$65,325.

### DIAZO DOING WELL AFTER SURGERY

After undergoing surgery for a fractured left front cannon bone, **Diazo** (Jade Hunter) is back in his stall at Santa Anita. "He looks good, doesn't he?" asked trainer Bill Shoemaker. Shoemaker said the prognosis is good that Diazo will get back to the track in six months, and he could race again. The four-year-old had two screws inserted to fuse the bone in an operation that lasted just under two hours Mon. morning at Southern California Equine Foundation Hospital. "They tell me if all goes well, the screws will be removed in three to three and a half months," said Shoemaker. "Then we'll know more about his chances."

**SANTA ANITA H.-GI, \$1,000,000, 4&up, 10f**  
A field of seven is taking shape for the Big 'Cap. Confirmed starters are **Kissin Kris** (Kris S.), Bailey, 119; **The Wicked North** (Far North), Desormeaux, 118; **Nonproductiveasset** (Stalwart), Nakatani, 116; **Region** (Devil's Bag), Delahoussaye, 116; **Hill Pass** (Temperence Hill), McCarron, 115; **Stuka** (Jade Hunter), Antley, 115; **Myrakalu** (Kaldoun {FR}), Solis, 113. Two horses are listed as possible starters. They are **Bien Bien** (Manila), McCarron, with Gary Stevens taking over on Hill Pass, 120; and **Corby** (Dahar), P. Valenzuela, 114. Myrakalu galloped Wed. and was pronounced "All set to go," by trainer D. Wayne Lukas. This will mark the turf specialist's first time racing on dirt. "Twilight Agenda and Criminal Type, they made a successful transition to dirt," said Lukas. "You never know until you try it, but it shouldn't be tough for Myrakalu to adapt. Since I've had him, all of his training has been on dirt and he's handled it well." Stuka went five furlongs in :59 1/5 at Santa Anita Tues. "We're ready," said his trainer, Gary Jones. Gil San Antonio H. winner **The Wicked North** looks to be the lone speed in the race. "Certainly, absolutely we want the lead," said trainer David Bernstein. "But we'll leave the riding to Kent (Desormeaux). He's four of five on him, so obviously he knows what to do." **Bien Bien** breezed a half-mile yesterday in :47 2/5. "He worked very well today," said trainer Paco Gonzalez. "We'll enter him, hope we draw an outside post position, and then we'll see. If we aren't satisfied with everything, we can always scratch him."

Yesterday's second entry stage for the Ever Ready Derby, to be run Wed., June 1, revealed that the Aga Khan has paid 10,000 pounds each to put his colts **Akhiyar (IRE)** (Doyoun {IRE}) and **Cajarian** (Shahrastani) into the Epsom Classic.
