DEHERE TO UNDERGO SURGERY

Dehere (Deputy Minister), who came out of a six-furlong workout Friday at Palm Beach Downs with a fracture of the right hind cannon bone, will undergo surgery at an undetermined Palm Beach-area clinic Monday or Tuesday, according to John Perrotta, general manager for Due Process Stables. The surgery will be performed by Colorado veterinarian Dr. Wayne McKilrath. "Mr. Brennan's main hope is to return Dehere to the races," said Perrotta. "We are hoping that the surgery will be successful and there will be no damage to the joint surface. We have to play it by ear but we are hoping for a 100% recovery. Some horses recover better than others, but he is a very intelligent horse and he is not the type to thrash around and hurt himself." Explained Nobles of the decision to treat the colt locally, "We didn't want him to travel too far and risk further damage. Dehere is receiving medication and is resting as well as can be expected."

DEVIL HIS DUE WITHDRAWN FROM GULFSTREAM PARK HANDICAP

Devil His Due (Devil's Bag) was withdrawn from today's Gulfstream Park Handicap. According to trainer Allen Jerkens, "He had a little blood in his nose when he came back from a little work (Saturday) morning. He scoped clean. There was no blood in his trachea. It may be sinus trouble. The vet was very surprised there was no blood when he scoped him. Although he scoped clean and probably is alright, Devil His Due is too valuable to run and take a chance."

"I saw a little crowding, but no, I didn't think (the DQ) would happen," said The Wicked North's trainer, David Bernstein. "But it's all a part of racing. Unfortunately it had to happen in this particular race." Gary Jones, trainer of Stuka, said, "My heart goes out to the people that won the race. That's a terrible thing. But the stewards have to do what they have to do. I've been wanting to win a race like this for Mr. Paulson since I first met the guy. He stuck with me through some tough things and I really appreciate it."

FLORIDA DERBY NEWS **Go For Gin** (Cormorant) worked five furlongs in :59 3/5 and **Crary** (Mt. Livermore) went six furlongs in 1:11 3/5 Saturday morning in preparation for next Saturday's Florida Derby. **Go For Gin** looms the likely favorite. "I am sorry for the loss of Dehere, because it is bad for the sport of racing," said Zito. "As far as **Go For Gin**, it doesn't matter. I don't look at anyone else's horses. You have to beat all of them." **Lahint** (Woodman) worked seven furlongs in 1:26 under Mike Smith and will start next in the Florida Derby, said trainer Bill Mott. Chris McCarron is scheduled to ride. The full brother to Hansel has won two of four starts, and was being pointed for the Louisiana Derby when he came down with a fever, missing several days of training. "I think that running in the Florida Derby actually might be beneficial in the long run," said Mott. "Granted, it may be tougher, but I don't have to ship anywhere, and it gives me more time to decide where to run next. I'll have more options."

Sunday's Gulfstream Park Handicap is a complex scramble. At handicap weights, any one of seven or eight horses could win this one. Fortunately, one of the ones who has almost no shot is morning-line favorite **Strolling Along** (Danzig), who has simply never run fast enough in his life, so there is some value as a betting event. This leaves **Migrating Moon** (Silver Buck) as the solid one, since his figures are good and he gets a break in the weights. We'll make him our pick, but will not be at all surprised if a longshot springs an upset. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many horsemen and professional handicappers to evaluate the ability of racehorses.
