**BIG 'CAP APPEAL DATE SET** The appeal on the disqualification of The Wicked North from first to fourth in last Saturday's Santa Anita H., filed by owner Philip Hersh and trainer David Bernstein, will be heard March 19. Bernstein also confirmed that the son of Far North will make his next start in the \$750,000 Oaklawn H. April 16.

**BARRETS SALE AVERAGE UP** Barretts Equine Limited held its March Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale at Fairplex Park in Pomona, Calif. March 8 and 9. Ninety-four hips were sold for a gross of \$10,808,000 and an average of \$114,979. This average represented a 57.2 percent increase over the 1993 figure of \$73,156. The sales topper, a roan colt by Trempolino--Mouthfull (Caro {IRE}), was consigned to the sale by D. Wayne Lukas and purchased by Calif. trainer Richard Mulhall for \$700,000 on behalf of an unnamed Arab client. The colt, a half-brother to Chenin Blanc (SW, \$692,132), was a \$45,000 Keeneland Nov. weanling and was purchased by Lukas at last year's Keeneland Sept. yearling sale for \$80,000. The second highest price of \$480,000 was brought by a half brother to Belong To Me (Gill, \$261,166, by Danzig) by Topsider--Belonging (Exclusive Native).

### BREEDERS' CUP DISCONTINUES

**STEEPLECHASE** Breeders' Cup officials have announced that the \$250,000 Breeders' Cup Steeplechase, the richest jump race in North America, has been discontinued. The race was first held in 1986.

**TURFWAY CARD CANCELLED** Racing was cancelled at Turfway Park Wed. night due to inclement weather. As a result, intertrack wagering at Keeneland was also called off.

**Gill \$100,000a BAY SHORE S., 3yo, 6f**

**Daunting Era** (Exclusive Era), prepping for the Bay Shore, breezed five furlongs Mon. over the Belmont training track in 1:02.86 seconds. The winner of the Feb. 20 Fred "Cappy" Caposella S. in his last outing, Daunting Era has won three of four lifetime starts. **Mr. Shawklit** (Afleet) worked five furlongs at Aqueduct Tues. in 1:01.59. The Frank LaBocchetta trainee will be making his first start since winning the Dec. 19 Safe Ground S. at Aqueduct, after which he pulled a stifle. "He's not going to be 100 percent," said LaBocchetta. "I'm pressured to get him a race, because it's hard to fill a non-winners of two race for three-year-olds before the Gotham. This isn't the real objective for him." **Shiprock** (Ga Hai) breezed three furlongs in :37 1/5 yesterday at Philadelphia Park. The Steve Rowan trainee is scheduled to ship to Aqueduct Sat. morning.

### Sunday, Gulfstream Park

**Gill \$300,000 Pan American H., 3yo/up, 12fT**

**Highweight Fraise** (Strawberry Road) had his final Pan American prep at Gulfstream yesterday morning, going five furlongs on the turf in 1:04 2/5 around the "dogs." "Fraise is training beautifully," said Mott of the six-year-old, who is going for his second straight in this event. "He has had two-and-a-half months to recover from his last race (third as the favorite in the McKnight H. at Calder). He has been moving well and working well; I think he will return to his normal form."

**SAM HOUSTON TO OFFER DAILY TV**

**COVERAGE** Sam Houston Race Park, Texas' first Class 1 horse racing facility, and Home Sports Entertainment, the nation's third-largest regional sports network, have joined forces to offer television coverage of each day's racing replays and each week's racing highlights on a regular basis. The coverage on the Liberty Media Corporation cable outlet will include a daily half-hour racing replay show and a half-hour weekly magazine-type highlights show. The racing replay show called "The Sam Houston Race Report" and the weekly magazine show named "The Stretch Run" will be hosted by Track Announcer and Director of Communications/Publicity Rick Mocklin. Sam Houston's \$85 million facility is scheduled to open April 29.
