### HORSEMEN, HIALEAH, FAIL TO AGREE

Representatives from the Florida HBPA and Hialeah failed to reach a contract agreement in a meeting Fri. afternoon. The two sides continued to disagree on Hialeah's takeout structure for its upcoming meet, opening March 17. Hialeah has announced takeout of 23 percent on straight wagers and 28 percent on exotics. The horsemen want Hialeah to cap the takeout at 18 and 25 percent. Without the horsemen's approval, Hialeah can't simulcast its signal outside of Florida. Scott Savin, Vice President of the FHBPA, said, "We told them we couldn't sign with that kind of takeout. They said they were going to sue us. I guess we'll wait to be served with papers." Hialeah Vice President John Van Lindt said that the track would not take that step. Asked what would happen Thurs. if the contract were not signed, Van Lindt replied, "I don't know. We'll have to see."

### AQUEDUCT TO MAIN TRACK MARCH 22

Racing will shift from the winterized inner track to the Aqueduct main track Tues., March 22. The main track opening was originally scheduled for March 9, but was delayed by bad weather. As is the case for this weekend's Bay Shore, the distance for next weekend's stakes, the Toboggan and Distaff, will be six, rather than seven, furlongs. In addition, Monday will become the usual dark day at both Aqueduct and Belmont during the 1994 racing schedule. Tuesday will remain the dark day at Saratoga. Aqueduct will continue to run seven live and five simulcast races through March 31 and then switch to nine live races.

**DESORMEAUX RECEIVES STAY** Jockey Kent Desormeaux has received a stay of suspension following the disqualification of The Wicked North in last Saturday's \$1 million Santa Anita H. His attorney, Roger Licht, said that a hearing on the suspension would take place after the appeal of the DQ.

**PANZA NAMED RACING SECRETARY AT HOLLYWOOD**

He will continue in that role, which has a compatible schedule with Hollywood.

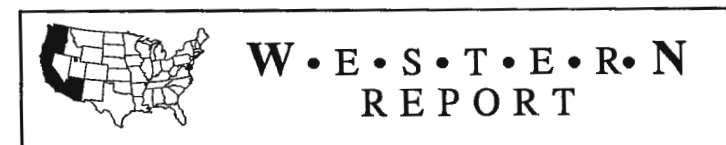
