CONTINUANCE GRANTED IN BIG 'CAP

HEARING A continuance has been granted to Philip Hersh and his trainer, David Bernstein, in the appeal of the disqualification of The Wicked North from first to fourth in the March 5 Santa Anita H. The appeal will not be heard March 19 as originally scheduled, and is now likely to be heard the week of April 17, according to steward Tom Ward.

MARIO PINO NOTCHES #3,000 Jockey Mario Pino recorded his 3,000th career victory aboard Simoom in the Politely S. at Laurel yesterday afternoon. A native of Wilmington, Delaware, Pino has been riding for 15 years. "I'm just glad it's over," said the 32-year-old rider. "I thought that number 3,000 might come today."

Racing will be conducted at Gulfstream Park Monday, originally carded to be a dark day. The program was added to the schedule to make up for an afternoon lost earlier in the meet due to track conditions. Gulfstream's highly successful season concludes Wednesday, March 16.
