## RECORD HANDLE FOR FLORIDA

**DERBY DAY** Gulfstream Park established a record for a Florida Derby Day total handle, with \$17,202,214 wagered on and off-track. The breakdown of Saturday's handle was \$5,218,550 on-track, \$1,302,934 from intertrack wagering and \$10,680,730 from interstate wagering (including \$4,272,109 from New York).

**FLORIDA DERBY WRAP-UP Holy Bull** (Great Above), runaway winner of yesterday's Florida Derby, came out of the race in top shape and will now head for Kentucky. "He came out of this race the best he has ever come out of a race," said trainer Jimmy Croll. "He ate up last night and he looks great. The Blue Grass (April 16) looks like the logical place to go." **Mr. Angel** (Cormorant), who finished 13th at odds of 12-1, had an excuse for his performance. "He bled pretty bad," said his trainer, Martin Wolfson. "We'll give him a week off. I'm going to keep him on the grass because I think he is exceptional there. He'll run next in the Forerunner S. (April 22 at Keeneland), then we'll go to the three-year-old turf series at Arlington."

## BROCCO, VALIANT NATURE WORK FOR

**SAN FELIPE** The two top contenders for next Sunday's \$200,000 San Felipe S. at Santa Anita worked yesterday. Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Brocco** (Kris S.) breezed seven furlongs in 1:25 1/5 and galloped out the mile in 1:39 with Gary Stevens aboard. Hollywood Futurity victor **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty) went a mile in a bullet 1:37 3/5. Both will make their three-year-old debuts in the San Felipe. Said Brocco's trainer, Randy Winick, "He finished up real big. Gary said he's as good right now as he was before the Breeders' Cup." Trainer Ron McAnally was also satisfied with his colt's work, and added that he may have a blowout later in the week.

The odds-on choice, **Lakeway** stalked pacesetter **Flying In The Lane** to midstretch, then went on to her fourth win in four tries under **Kent Desormeaux**. "Anybody could ride her," said the jockey. "She just gallops around there. It's amazing she finished just two ticks off the stake record. She was just playing at the end. She's still got tons of play in her, which means if someone would come to her, she would go on, without any doubt." The winner paid \$2.60; she is likely to make her next start in the **Kentucky Oaks**. "I've always felt the **Kentucky Oaks** is as just as prestigious a race for the fillies as the **Kentucky Derby** is for colts," said trainer **Gary Jones**. "As far as the (Santa Anita) Derby goes, we'll have to wait and see, but I don't anticipate her running in that race."

## ON TAP AT • GULFSTREAM

The unbeaten three-year-old **Canaveral**, who did not get into Saturday's Florida Derby because of insufficient earnings, will try to add to his bankroll and his reputation on closing day at Gulfstream Park. The son of **Relaunch**, trained by **Frank Brothers**, will face seven rivals in the \$50,000 sixth race, an allowance for three-year-olds at a mile and a sixteenth. Two-for-two at the meet, **Canaveral** began his career taking a seven-furlong maiden race January 7; he came back a month later to take a mile-and-a-sixteenth allowance event.
