HIALEAH, HORSEMEN AGREE ON

CONTRACT The Florida HBPA and Hialeah Park met before the Honorable Lenore Nesbitt of the U.S. Southern District Court yesterday and as a result, the FHBPA has agreed to a contract with Hialeah which calls for \$100,000 a day in purses. The horsemen have 10 days to file a brief in support of the Interstate Horse Racing Act; Hialeah will have five days to respond. Until the judge rules, the track will be allowed to simulcast its races outside the state of Florida. In a related matter, Art Laughlin, general manager of the Palm Beach Kennel Club and the Palm Beach Jai Alai Fronton, said his two intertrack sites, which accounted for 38 percent of Gulfstream's intertrack business this winter, would not be taking the signal from Hialeah. Said Laughlin, "Hialeah is trying to get it both ways; they want us to charge the gamblers 28 percent and then they want us to sign a contract to take the same percentage as Gulfstream and Calder gave us. I've had good customers tell me they'll see me after the Hialeah meet ends."

BOWEN NAMED DIRECTOR OF GRAYSON-JOCKEY CLUB FOUNDATION

The Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation announced yesterday the appointment of Edward L. Bowen as Executive Director, while Dr. Ed Ford, who has served as Director since 1984, takes on the newly created post of Director of Research. Bowen, an Eclipse Award-winning journalist, is the president of the Thoroughbred Club of America and vice-president of the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame.

LAST WEEK ON THE TRIPLE CROWN TRAIL

Holy Bull (Great Above) moved back to the head of the class with a powerful win in the GI Florida Derby Saturday. The wire-to-wire win left Derby hopefuls **Ride The Rails** (Cryptoclearance), **Halo's Image** (Halo) and **Go For Gin** (Cormorant) to fight for the minor awards. Holy Bull will go on to the Blue Grass (Apr. 16); Go For Gin is scheduled to run in the Wood Memorial (Apr. 16); and Ride The Rails will go to the Arkansas Derby (Apr. 23). Plans for Halo's Image are still up in the air.

In Arkansas, **Polar Expedition** (Kodiack) saw his win streak stopped at six, settling for third behind the promising **Southern Rhythm** (Dixieland Band), who rallied from last to gain his first stakes win in the one-mile Southwest S. at Oaklawn.

Also earning his first black-type win this weekend was longshot **Arrival Time** (Time for a Change), who scored at 26-1 in the GIII seven-furlong Swale S. at Gulfstream. While his next start has not yet been determined, trainer Frank Alexander has indicated he would like to try the colt at a distance.

New York's Bay Shore S., run at six instead of seven furlongs, saw the sprinter **Prank Call** (Phone Trick), who is not nominated to the Triple Crown, come home first. Favored **Popol's Gold** (Strike Gold), beaten only 1 1/4, was compromised by the shorter distance; he and runner-up **Mr. Shawklit** (Afleet) are expected back for the one-mile Gotham March 26.

GRAY CASHMERE, AZTEC HILL RETURN AT OAKLAWN SATURDAY GSW's **Gray Cashmere** (Relaunch), runner-up in the balloting for last year's champion older mare, and **Aztec Hill** (Proud Truth), one of '93's top three-year-old fillies with victories in the GII Fantasy and GII Black-Eyed Susan, may face off in their seasonal debuts in the \$50,000a Pippin S. at Oaklawn Sat. Gray Cashmere has not started since winning the Falls City H. at Churchill last Nov. "Our objective is the Apple Blossom H. April 22," said her trainer, Pete Vestal. Aztec Hill took the Sunbonnet S. at Aqueduct last out Dec. 3.

THIS WEEK'S TRIPLE CROWN PREPS

GII \$300,000 Louisiana Derby, 3/19, 8.5f, Fair Grounds

California-bred **Argolid** (Saras {GB}) worked a mile in 1:39 2/5 at Santa Anita Sunday in preparation his trip to Louisiana. "He got a little tired but the work definitely did him some good," said trainer Bob Baffert. "He's making up for that week he missed (due to an abscess)." The colt, with a record of two wins and two seconds in four starts, was scheduled to ship Mon. He will meet local hero **Fly Cry** (On To Glory), who has taken three stakes in a row at the oval.

GII \$200,000a San Felipe S., 3/20, 8.5f, Santa Anita

Two of last year's top juveniles, **Brocco** (Kris S.) and **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty), will make their three-year-old debuts at Santa Anita Sunday. The two last met in the Hollywood Futurity in Dec., with Valiant Nature 3/4 to the good of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner. Charlie Whittingham's promising **Strodes Creek** (Halo) is also possible for the race

\$100,000 John Battaglia Memorial S., 3/19, 8.5f, Turfway Park

Dynafleet (Dynaformer) and **Sir Walter Lyzalot** (Fuzzy), one-two, respectively, in a Turfway allowance March 6, will meet again in Saturday's featured race. "He's just now really learning how to run," said Dynafleet's trainer, Vickie Foley. "And we know the farther he runs, the better."

\$100,000 Gold Rush S., 3/19, 8.5f, Golden Gate

Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer will send out Golden Bear S. winner **Double Jab** (Rajab) in this prep for the California Derby (Apr. 16). The colt is looking for his third straight win, and tries a mile and a sixteenth for the first time. "I think he'll get any distance because he relaxes and doesn't have to be on the front end," said Hollendorfer.

\$100,000 Great West S., 3/19, 8f 70yds, Remington

Oklahoma-bred **Silver Goblin** (Silver Ghost) stretches out and tries two turns for the first time going for his sixth win in seven career starts.
