GULFSTREAM WRAP-UP Gulfstream Park Wed. completed the most successful Thoroughbred racing meeting in Florida history with increases in on-track mutuel handle and attendance in addition to record commingled mutuel play. For the 62-day meeting, the total from all sources was a record \$560,962,021. This compares with last year's total of \$387,019,482 for a 68-day season. The average on-track handle for the recently concluded meeting was \$1,948,519, an 11.94 percent increase from last year. Average commingled handle of \$7,465,874 was up 104.16 percent and average on-track attendance rose 4.24 percent. Jockey Mike Smith topped the standings with 80 victories. Bill Mott ran away with the trainers' title with 32 winners. Robert Brennan's Due Process Stables headed the owner's standings in money earned (\$395,870) and tied for the most wins (10) with Darley Stud Management.

PURSE INCREASES AT OAKLAWN Oaklawn Park President Charles J. Cella announced that a substantial across-the-board purse increase will be extended to horsemen at the track beginning Wed., March 23 and extending to the end of the Oaklawn race meet, Sat., April 23. This boost marks the second in less than a month. "We are excited about making this move at this time, because it shows horsemen both here and around the country that we are good to our word--that we are striving to provide the highest purse structure in the midwest," said Cella. This is the sixth consecutive season at Oaklawn in which business success has resulted in such action. The increase will raise purses an average of 10 percent, and is added onto the jump announced March 4 which raised the overnight purse schedule five percent.

ITSALLGREEKTOME RETIRED Itsallgreetome (Sovereign Dancer), the Champion Turf Horse of 1990, has been retired after fracturing a left front sesamoid. Trainer Bob Hess Jr. said the injury showed Wed. following a Tues. workout at Hollywood, and added it is not life-threatening. The seven-year-old gelding won eight races, including the GI Hollywood Turf Cup and the GI Hollywood Derby, for earnings of \$1,994,618.
