LOBLOLLY PARTNERSHIP TO BE

DISSOLVED John Ed Anthony and Mary Lynn Dudley, who founded Loblolly Stable in 1971 but were divorced in 1988, have decided to dissolve their thoroughbred partnership as well. Loblolly runners took the last two editions of the Preakness S.; the phaseout will begin with the dispersal of Loblolly's 21 homebred yearlings at the 1994 Keeneland Summer and Fall Sales. Loblolly will also offer all in-foal mares under 15 years of age in the Keeneland November Sale. The current two-year-old crop will join the older horses at the track; the stable will wind down its operation over the next several years under the direction of trainer Tom Bohannon. But John Ed Anthony will continue his involvement in the thoroughbred industry. "While Mary Lynn does not wish to remain in the business, I do plan to continue in racing and breeding and expect to be active at the sales. The basic team responsible for the development of Loblolly will rebuild a thoroughbred operation which will race in my name," said Anthony.

TOP ENGLISH RUNNER HEADED FOR JAPAN

The winner of last year's 1,000 Guineas, **Sayedati** (Shadeed), will have her first start as a three-year-old in the GII Keio Hai Spring Cup at Tokyo Race Course April 23. The Clive Brittain-trained filly will then remain in Japan for the GI Yasuda Kinen May 15.

Classy Mirage (Storm Bird) tries to break her three-race 1994 losing streak; the four-year-old ended 1993 with five wins in a row. "We'll add blinkers to her this race," said Jimmy Jerkens, assistant to his father and the filly's trainer, Allen Jerkens. "There will be a larger cup on the outside. She's been bearing out a little lately; this might help her stay in a little bit." The filly scored her last victory in the '93 GII Prioress at Belmont; she breezed three furlongs in :35.31 Friday morning. "She appears to be coming around again," said the younger Jerkens. "After the breeze, she seemed to perk up a little. We're hoping she turns it around." She will face highweight **Family Enterprize** (Tri Jet), who took her measure in an allowance at Gulfstream Feb. 17 and came back to win the Heather H. at the south Florida track in her last start.
