SANTA ANITA DERBY ON ABC-TV

The \$500,000 GI Santa Anita Derby will be televised, live on the East Coast and tape-delayed on the West Coast, during ABC's "Wide World of Sports" April 9. Post time for the race will be 2:49 p.m., PDT.

FULL FIELD FOR GOTHAM

A field of 10 to 14 is expected for next Saturday's GI \$250,000 Gotham S. at Aqueduct. Trainer Steve Young confirmed yesterday he would be sending the promising **Irgun** (Sunny's Halo) from California for the race. The speedy three-year-old finished second by a half-length to the highly regarded Strodes Creek in his last start, a Santa Anita allowance. **Popol's Gold** (Strike Gold), winner of the Nashua S. last fall and more recently third in the six-furlong Bay Shore, had his final Gotham prep at Laurel Saturday, going five furlongs in :59. "I think he benefitted from the Bay Shore," said his trainer, Billy Turner. "He came out of it good and he seems to be heading in the right direction." **Mr. Meadow** (Meadowlake) will also ship up from Maryland for the one-mile Gotham. The colt ran third in Aqueduct's Fred "Cappy" Capossela S. after a five-month layoff for bucked shins; he is scheduled to ship to New York Thursday.

Thoro-Graph Analysis

Sunday's San Felipe is not much of a betting race. The two favorites are obviously the best horses and handicappers can only guess at their fitness, since their trainers have eyes for bigger prizes further down the road. But there is another point to make here.

Since Thoro-Graph began putting performance figures on graphs in 1982, every single Kentucky Derby winner has fit the same profile: slow or unraced over the summer as a two-year-old, but developing strongly after Labor Day. Dehere and Holy Bull do not fit the profile, but **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty) and **Brocco** (Kris S.) do (along with some others). As three-year-olds, all the Derby winners got stronger through the spring, running the best race of their lives shortly before the Derby. Holy Bull has already done some very serious running, and may be going the wrong way come the first Saturday in May. But Valiant Nature and Brocco have been brought along carefully and will only have two starts before the Derby, preventing them from peaking too soon. Brocco, especially, is pretty much the prototype of the contemporary Derby winner, and at this point is the most likely winner; the picture will be even clearer in a couple of weeks.

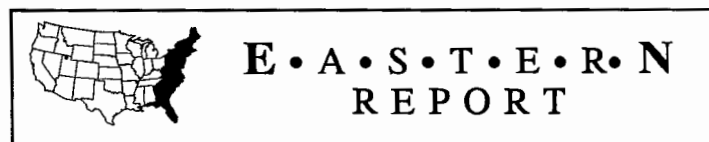

Southern Truce (Truce Maker) is the morning-line favorite to successfully defend her title in the GIII \$100,000 Miss America H. at Golden Gate Fields this afternoon. Winner of the GI Santa Monica in her last start, the six-year-old will face only three rivals in the mile-and-a-sixteenth feature.

At Turf Paradise, **Honor The Hero** (Hero's Honor) will try to match last year's performance with a repeat victory in the six-furlong, GIII \$100,000 Phoenix Gold Cup. The 8x SW has won his last two coming into this year's edition of the race, taking an allowance and the Hot Springs S. at Oaklawn at the Phoenix Gold Cup distance. He will face a pair of California shippers in the eight-horse field: **Saratoga Gambler** (Saratoga Six), who won and was claimed for \$100,000 last time out; and **Davy Be Good** (Blue Eyed Davy), who is 0-for-3 in 1994 but finished a good third in the El Conejo H. at Santa Anita in his most recent start.
