RIVER VERDON TAKES HONG KONG GOLD CUP

Six-year-old Irish-bred **River Verdon** (Be My Native), repeating his success of the last two years, captured his third consecutive Hong Kong Gold Cup at Sha-Tin Race Course Sunday. Ridden by Australian John Marshall and trained by Englishman David Hill, River Verdon defeated American-bred five-year-old **Deerfield** (Summing) by six-and-a-quarter lengths in the mile-and-a-quarter event; Irish-bred **Aman's Sax** was another three lengths back in third. The winner will make his next start in the Champions & Charter Cup May 15.

FAIR GROUNDS SETS HANDLE RECORD The total handle for Saturday's Louisiana Derby Day card at the Fair Grounds came to \$4,568,320, a one-day record for the New Orleans oval. The handle included \$2,083,890 bet on-track and at full card simulcasts, and \$2,484,430 bet on Louisiana Derby simulcasts.

FINGER LAKES ANNOUNCES '94 STAKES SCHEDULE

The \$200,000a GIII Finger Lakes Budweiser Breeders' Cup Saturday, July 2, highlights the 170-day racing season at Finger Lakes which begins April 8. The Budweiser Breeders' Cup is one of 15 stakes scheduled for the '94 meet at the Farmington, New York racetrack. New York-breds will have the chance for major paydays in the \$75,000 New York Oaks (three-year-old fillies, Aug. 20), the \$125,000 New York Derby (three-year-olds, Aug. 20) and the \$150,000 New York Breeders' Futurity (two-year-olds, Oct. 10). There will be no racing Wednesday's at Finger Lakes this year, with racing conducted Friday through Tuesday.

The much-awaited duel between Brocco and Valiant Nature did develop--but it was for the runner-up spot as 6-1 Soul Of The Matter flew from last to first to win going away under Kent Desormeaux. It was the first stakes win for the colt, who paid \$14.60. "He couldn't have had a better set up," said the rider. "Everything worked out great for him today." Trainer Richard Mandella remarked, "The race went absolutely like we planned. We're very excited to be in the position we're in right now. We'll look at one more spot before the Kentucky Derby, but we're not sure which one it will be. Santa Anita would be the likely one." Brocco earned the favorite's role and second money; said jockey Gary Stevens, "He got a lot out of it. He should improve dramatically off of this race." Valiant Nature's pilot, Laffit Pincay Jr., also believes his mount will move forward off the San Felipe. "He got tired, but he wasn't giving up like most horses do; he kept on going. I think this race is going to do him a lot of good. It's tough on a horse that comes from a long layoff to run on a fast track, but today it was heavy and that's even tougher." Both colts are expected back for the Santa Anita Derby (April 9).
