**OJC APPROVES GREENWOOD SALE** An agreement to sell Greenwood Racetrack was approved yesterday by the Board of Trustees of the Ontario Jockey Club. The property is being sold to a wholly owned subsidiary of River Oaks Developments Inc., which is controlled by Toronto developer Herbert Green. There will be no loss of jobs with the sale of Greenwood, as the OJC intends to continue to operate the Champions Tele-wagering facility on the Greenwood site, subject to regulatory approval. Said Marvin Green, president of the the River Oaks Group, "We are most pleased to be embarking on this project. We intend to work with residents, government agencies and others to develop the lands in a way which contibutes positively to the community. The development of the Greenwood site represents a rare and exciting opportunity to create new housing while...generating jobs and contributing to the economy of the City of Toronto."

**LADY BLESSINGTON RETIRED** Graded stakes winner **Lady Blessington** (Baillamont), who took the GI All Along S. at Laurel last year and the GIII Buena Vista at Santa Anita Feb. 27, has been retired and will be bred to Summer Squall. The six-year-old mare won 12 of her 27 career starts and earned \$664,112; she finished fourth but was moved up to third in her last start, the GI Santa Ana H. March 19. The French-bred Team Valor runner will be shipped to Taylor Made Farm in Lexington this weekend. She is scheduled to sell in Keeneland's November sale.

**IRISH ACRES DISPERSAL** A total of 43 lots were sold for \$753,500 during the complete dispersal of Irish Acres in Ocala Wednesday. Attracting the highest bid was the five-year-old mare One Wild Woman, who was sold for \$110,000 to Miami Bloodstock. The average for the sale was \$17,523.

**GSW Popol's Gold** (Strike Gold) will try to move up off his third-place effort in the Bay Shore last time out. "I was pleased with the way he ran in the Bay Shore," said trainer Billy Turner. "He ran with authority. He dropped back on the turn and came running in the stretch." Turner would like to see the gelding use the same tactics in the Gotham. "The one-turn mile usually makes for a very fast first half-mile," he remarked. "It's not uncommon to see two horses together every step of the way. That takes its toll on the horses." Trainer Steve Young has brought the speedy **Irgun** (Sunny's Halo) in from California for the race. The Gotham will be his third start. "The only way to get seasoning is by running," said Young. "It's a 'Catch-22' situation. Obviously, he's a little behind the others but he's a good horse. I like to let the horse do the talking on the track."

**CHRB UNVEILS SECURITY PLAN** The California Horse Racing Board yesterday unveiled a three-part plan to revamp backstretch security, improve the drug-testing program and standardize penalties for persons who violate drug and medication rules. Under the plan, all security officers will receive extensive training in drug enforcement. CHRB investigators will spend more time in the stable area and there will be increased surveillance activities in the stable area. Another aspect of the plan involves guidelines for the adjudication of drug-related violations. Using the drug classification guidelines of the Association of Racing Commissioners International as a base, the CHRB has tentatively expanded its list to seven classes ranging from potent stimulants and depressants (Class 1) to drugs which are routinely used in health care (Class 7). Proposed penalties call for a one-to-three year suspension for first-time offenders in Class 1 cases, with a possible lifetime suspension for a third Class 1 offense; Class 7 violations would range from a \$100 fine for a first offense to a \$1,500 fine and a 15-day suspension for the third offense.

**EPSOM IN FAVOUR OF SUNDAY DERBY** Racecourse Holdings Trust, new lease-holder at Epsom, has been advised to consider transferring the Derby from its usual Wednesday slot to Sunday. Tim Neligan, the track's managing director, is strongly in favour of RHT's plans to boost the Classic's spectator appeal, but is against a switch to Saturday because local business people oppose a move which will disrupt the London suburb's traditional shopping day. The move would be hindered by the fact that Sunday on-course betting is still prohibited under current British gambling law.
