EPSOM DERBY PROSPECT DIES AT

NEWMARKET Bude (Dancing Brave), one of the top prospects for this year's Epsom Derby, died on the Newmarket gallops Saturday morning. The Henry Cecil-trained three-year-old was galloping with two stablemates when he slowed dramatically; he was pulled up by his exercise rider, but within minutes collapsed and died. No details are currently known about the cause of death, but Cecil's assistant, Simon Sweeting, confirmed that a full autopsy would be carried out. Bude earned his place among the Derby favourites with an impressive maiden win followed by a third in the GI Racing Post Trophy at two.

DANZERO TAKES AUSTRALIA'S GOLDEN SLIPPER

Danzero, a two-year-old son of the Danzig stallion Danehill, captured Australia's most valuable and prestigious race for juveniles, winning the Tooheys Golden Slipper S. at Rosehill Racecourse by a short head Saturday. Trained by Lee Friedman, Danzero defeated favored St. Covet in the roughly run six-furlong event, with Racer's Edge third. Trainer David Hayes saddled the second, third and fourth finishers in the race. Jockey Shane Dye aboard St. Covet lodged a claim of foul against the winner, and Steven King, on fifth-placed Hurricane Sky, claimed against both the winner and the runner-up, but the stewards allowed the result to stand. Danzero earned \$1,222,500 Australian for his victory.

Settling off the pace early, 8-5 favorite Irgun launched a powerful drive after a half-mile that carried jockey Jerry Bailey to an easy victory. The California shipper earned his first stakes win in his third career start and paid \$5.40. "He actually pulled me to the lead--earlier than I wanted to be on the lead," said Bailey. "But he's a big horse and I didn't want to cramp him down. He won very impressively." Trainer Steve Young remarked, "I let Jerry do what he wanted to do--he knows how to ride as well as anybody. My horse accomplished a lot today. This was the slowest track he's ever run on; he didn't have his track today. He shipped 3,000 miles. He cleared some big hurdles today. He beat these horses well enough to improve off this race. He'll run in the Wood (April 16) next." Howie Tesher, trainer of runner-up Bit of Puddin, said his colt would also run next in the Wood. "I thought he ran a really good race," he said. "He got sick when he came back from California; he was off the whole month of February." Trainer John Veitch was also pleased with the performance of third-place finisher Jesse F. "He needed this race badly. He's a great big horse who gains a ton of weight when he doesn't run. He'll run much better in the Wood than he did today."
