SIBLINGS TAKE SANTA ANITA STAKES Saturday was a banner day for the broodmare **Symbolically** (Flying Paster). Her three-year-old daughter **Pirate's Revenge** (Pirate's Bounty) started the day, earning her very first stakes win with a game nose decision in the restricted Boo La Boo S. at Santa Anita. Not to be outdone, five-year-old full brother **Echo of Yesterday** came back three races later to take the Crystal Water H. for Cal-breds by 2 3/4. "Symbolically has been very good to us," said trainer Ron Ellis, who conditions both horses for owner/breeders Martin and Pam Wygood. "We claimed her six or seven years ago and she won two races right off the bat for us, and then she was claimed away. Mr. Wygood then claimed her right back, specifically as a broodmare." Pirate's Revenge, with a record of three wins from just four career starts, may make her next start in the Gil Beaumont S. at Keeneland April 10, while her brother will be freshened for a late summer/fall campaign--pointing for the Cal Cup Classic. Wygood, who had three winners on Saturday's card, is currently the leading owner at the meet with 11 victories.

NEW GENERAL MANAGER FOR TURF

PARADISE Hollywood Park's Chief Operating Officer, R.D. Hubbard, has announced his intention to name Lonny T. Powell general manager of Turf Paradise when the acquisition of the Arizona track by Hollywood Park, Inc. is completed. Powell is currently president of Hubbard's Multnomah Greyhound Park near Portland, Oregon. He also served as general manager at the inaugural Woodlands meet in Kansas, executive vice president and COO of Longacres Park, and as a coordinator of the University of Arizona Racetrack Industry Program. Sent off as the even-money choice in the field of five, **Bien Bien** proved worthy of the confidence of the crowd, sitting off the fractions of **Navire** (FR) for 10 furlongs, then taking the lead and cruising to victory under jockey **Chris McCarron**. "He was training beautifully for the race," said his conditioner, **Paco Gonzalez**. "It was fortunate that we got a firm turf course. He ran big and I'm really happy. It was like a workout; I guess this is one of the easiest races he's won. We're leaning to the Hollywood Park race (\$500,000 Hollywood Turf H., May 30) as opposed to the **San Juan Capistrano** (Santa Anita, Apr. 24). We'll see." **Bien Bien**, a half-brother to **Dr. Schwartzman** (Fluorescent Light), GSW of \$380,362 and **Fantasy Lover** (Raja Baba), SW of \$106,070, paid \$2.60.

"He had never run a bad race until the Woodward (finishing last) last year," said trainer Rusty Arnold. "His legs kind of slipped out behind him at the start and he injured a stifle, so we blew the fall campaign and gave him six months off. He ran very hard today and got tired, which was to be expected. He loves those big sweeping turns at Belmont, which is where he'll go now, and then we'll decide what's next." West by West paid \$12.00; his record is now 23-9-2-5 with \$874,433 in earnings.
