RECORD CROWD, HANDLE FOR

TURFWAY'S JIM BEAM A record crowd of 20,189 was on hand at Turfway Park yesterday to watch the GII Jim Beam S. The Kentucky Derby prep highlighted a day in which fans wagered a record \$3,223,778 on track and \$2,600,563 at nine Kentucky inter-track sites. The previous on-track record was set April 2, 1988, when \$2,955,985 passed through the windows; the previous inter-track record was \$1,839,940 bet March 28, 1992.

TOBA OWNERS SEMINAR AT GOLDEN

GATE The Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association has scheduled a seminar for new owners at Golden Gate Fields Saturday, April 16--the day of the California Derby. The seminar will cover how to become an owner and what to expect once you're in the game. Topics will include partnerships, buying at auction, claiming, selecting a trainer, pedigrees and the cost of ownership.

SANTA ANITA DERBY UPDATE Trainer Mel Stute sent **Robannier** (Batonnier) out for his last major Santa Anita Derby prep Saturday morning; the California Juvenile S. winner went seven-eighths in 1:25 3/5. Alex Solis will be ride the colt next Saturday. Trainer Charlie Whittingham, who is looking for his third win in the Santa Anita Derby after saddling Temperate Sil (Temperence Hill) to win in '87 and Sunday Silence (Halo) to the '89 victory, may put blinkers on **Strodes Creek** (Halo) for this year's edition of the race. The Kentucky-bred colt had blinkers on for his seven-furlong breeze Thursday, and jockey Corey Black felt they helped the lightly raced three-year-old. "It was definitely an improvement, but not a drastic one," said Black. "He's not a brilliant work horse. He only does what you make him do. But he finished well. I wouldn't trade places with anybody."

Going right to the lead from his inside post, second choice Polar Expedition held a clear advantage 'til the stretch then dug in gamely to take the photo. It was the three-year-old's sixth win from his last seven starts and moves his stats to 9-7-0-2 and \$699,025. "I think the one hole helped a lot," said jockey Curt Bourque, "but you have to give him a lot of credit. He's a really big-hearted horse. The five horse (Powis Castle) had all kinds of chances to get by us and he never did." Trainer Hugh Robertson had indicated that his gelding would run next in the Illinois Derby (Apr. 30), but he may change his mind. "Right now, we're making no decision one way or another," he remarked. "We'll let him relax off this race and see what happens in some of the other preps. Everybody wants to go to the Kentucky Derby, but you have to look at the race and see what you think would be the best thing to do with your horse. You don't want to go to the Derby just for the sake of saying you've been there." Runner-up Powis Castle moved into second after a half but could not get by the winner, who paid \$10.00. The Thoro-Graph exacta came back \$37.40. Southern Rhythm (Dixieland Band), sent off the 5-2 chalk, made a move from sixth on the far turn but faded in the drive. "I don't have any excuses," said his rider, Chris McCarron. "He didn't really fire today."

Canaveral (Relaunch) will try to keep his unbeaten streak alive when he makes his stakes debut in the Flamingo. Bumped out of the Florida Derby due to insufficient earnings, the Morven Stud colorbearer took a mile-and-a-sixteenth allowance at Gulfstream as much the best in his most recent start. He stretches out an extra sixteenth and tries a track other than Gulfstream for the first time today. **Bay Street Star** (Silver Buck) went nine furlongs in the Lord Avie S. last out and galloped by 18 1/2 over a sloppy track in the off-the-turf event; it was his first win since breaking his maiden at Calder last September.
