## SECOND ENGLISH CLASSIC HOPEFUL DIES AFTER TRAINING INJURY

**Stonehatch** (Storm Bird), second top-rated two-year-old in Europe last season, has been put down following an injury sustained on his home gallops. The Peter Chapple-Hyam trainee, winner last year of Royal Ascot's Coventry S. and rated just one pound behind Dewhurst hero Grand Lodge, suffered a hairline pelvis fracture while working at Manton (Wiltshire) Friday. The colt, under veterinary supervision, was put into a supportive harness, but was in great pain Saturday and the decision was made to put him down. Owned by Robert Sangster, the colt was buried on the Manton estate. Stonehatch was the second Classic hope to die under similar circumstances this season. Henry Cecil's leading Derby contender **Bude** (Dancing Brave) collapsed after routine work at Newmarket March 26; an autopsy report revealed massive internal haemorrhaging due to a fractured pelvis.

**NAKATANI INJURED AT SANTA ANITA** Jockey Corey Nakatani, who was unseated during the stretch run of Saturday's sixth race at Santa Anita when his mount, Flying Marfa, ducked into the rail, suffered a fractured right ankle and will miss six-to-eight weeks. "It was a clean break of the ankle and no surgery was needed," said his agent, Bob Meldahl. "Corey was able to go home (Saturday) night."

**CANADIAN CHAMP WORKS AT WOODBINE** **Apelia** (Cool Victor), Canada's champion sprinter in 1993, stepped off four furlongs in :46 3/5 at Woodbine Sunday morning. The Knob Hill Stable five-year-old spent the winter at Payson Park in Florida after winning five of eight starts at four, including the GII Genuine Risk S. at Belmont Park. It has not yet been announced when the mare will make her '94 debut. News cont. p2

Surprising the crowd but not his connections, 26-1 Meadow Flight sat just off the early fractions of 2-5 favorite Canaveral (Relaunch) 'til the stretch, then strode to the lead and away from the field with jockey Craig Perret enjoying the ride. "We've always thought he would go a distance," said trainer Jim Ryerson of the colt who was trying two turns for the first time. "I've told Mr. Pivnik (owner) all along that I was confident of his ability, but that he was just behind some of the other three-year-olds. He had two setbacks last year--once with a virus and then a stifle problem. After that, we pretty much were pointing to this race. He's not an intense horse, and sprinting really isn't him. I can't really tell you what will be next. I'll just have to wait and see how much this race does or doesn't take out of him. Certainly under the right conditions the Derby would be a possibility." Jockey Shane Sellers, aboard Canaveral, commented, "I don't know what happened. He was just not on the bridle. When I asked him to pick it up, he just couldn't. I just kept hollering at him and hollering at him but he didn't respond. I don't know if he bled or not. He's a better horse than he showed today." Trainer Frank Brothers said, "He seems to be fine. I'm not sure I can say the same for the trainer. We'll have to see, but there is no visible sign that he bled."

Hollywood Futurity winner **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty) was out on the track at Santa Anita Sunday morning, stretching his legs in 1:13 3/5 for six furlongs. Third in the San Felipe over a muddy track in his three-year-old bow, the colt will not start Saturday if the track is off. "If the track comes up muddy like it did for the San Felipe, there's no way we'll run," said trainer Ron McAnally. "We'd probably go to the Blue Grass (Apr. 16)."
