NINE LATE NOMINATIONS TO TRIPLE

CROWN The final count on late nominations to the 1994 Chrysler Triple Crown Challenge stands at nine. The late nominees are **Bay Street Star** (Silver Buck), second in Sun.'s GIII Flamingo S. at Hialeah, Mike Rutherford's undefeated filly **Lakeway** (Seattle Slew), Clark, Domush, Silver & Thirlot's **Bai Brun** (White Mischief), Halo Farms' and Jerry Hollendorfer's **Double Jab** (Rajab), Lazy Lane Farms' **Andover Scholar** (Alydar), Saul Kupferberg's **Copper Mount** (Cormorant), Cobble View Stable's **Pad** (Notebook), Robert Perez's **Ulises** (Temperence Hill) and Robert B. Lewis' **Marconi (IRE)** (Sadler's Wells). The late nomination deadline was Sat., April 2. The nine late nominees bring the Triple Crown Challenge total to 363.

BROCCO IN FINAL DERBY PREP Trainer Randy Winick pronounced Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Brocco** (Kris S.) fit and ready for Sat.'s GI Santa Anita Derby following a half-mile workout yesterday morning. "He came out of the work good, he's doing super," said Winick following a :46 3/5 blowout on Santa Anita's fast main track with regular rider Gary Stevens in the saddle. "Now all we have to do is put him to bed until the race. He'll walk tomorrow (Thurs.), gallop Fri. and run Sat."

JOCKEY ERIC VALLES INJURED AT

HIALEAH According to Hialeah Park track physician Dr. O.V. Carr, jockey Eric Valles, who was unseated from his mount **Dover Rock** (Mogambo) in yesterday's second race, was transported to Hialeah Hospital for X-rays and treatment of a probable broken left clavicle. Carr also noted that no other serious injuries were apparent, though Valles was complaining of severe discomfort in his collarbone area.

ARGOLID INJURED Mike Pegram's **Argolid** (Saros {GB}), third in the GIII Louisiana Derby in his last outing, will miss the Arkansas Derby at Oaklawn April 23, trainer Bob Baffert said Wed. "He popped another quarter crack," Baffert said, "so I'm bringing him back here to Santa Anita Fri. That way I can keep him under my wing and keep an eye on how he's doing. Right now our plans are indefinite." The Triple Crown hopeful, who is currently stabled at Oaklawn, had previously popped a quarter on his left fore.

Saturday, Aqueduct

BED o' ROSES H.-GII, \$100,000a, 3&up, f&m, 8f
A select field of seven is shaping up. Three-time GI winner **Dispute** (Danzig) worked five furlongs in :59 3/5 over the Belmont training track Sat. The four-year-old, who has won seven of 14 races and \$795,156 to date, came off a four month hiatus to finish third to Bed o' Roses probable **For All Seasons** (Crafty Prospector) in the March 12 Safely Kept H. at Gulfstream last out. Dispute's main challenger is expected to be the talented sprinter **Classy Mirage** (Storm Bird), 4 1/2-length winner of the six furlong GII Distaff H. at Aqueduct March 20. Rounding out the field of probables are **Avie's Daisy** (Lord Avie), **Reach for Clever** (Wrinkle Dinkle), **Hooded Dancer** (Gate Dancer) and **Incinerate** (Groovy).

BOLD RULER H.-GIII, \$100,000a, 3&up, 6f
Chief Desire (Chief Steward), winner of the Sporting Plate H. at Aqueduct two starts back, has never finished out of the money in 20 career outings. The four-year-old breezed four furlongs in :53 Sun. over Belmont's training track. **Boom Towner** (Obli-gato), a three-time graded stakes-winner, has not raced since his victory in the GIII Sport Page H. at Aqueduct Nov. 25. The Mike Hushion trainee worked five furlongs in 1:00 2/5 handily over Belmont's training track Sat. in preparation for his return. Others considered probable for the race are **Preporant** (Cormorant), **Evil Bear** (Medieval Man), **Fabersham** (Nepal), **Tough Heart** (Star Gallant) and **Won Song** (Air Forbes Won). **Thelastcrusade** (Northern Majesty) and **Crafty Alfel** (Crafty Prospector) are listed as possible starters.
