## INTERSTATE HORSE RACING ACT

**UPHELD** The Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals Wednesday unanimously reversed the lower court opinion which found the Interstate Horse Racing Act of 1978 unconstitutional in a Sept. 20 ruling. The Court's Opinion recognizes that "horsemen have a vested interest in the added revenue that off-track wagering provides;" with respect to the horsemen's veto rights under the Act, the Court stated that "horsemen have a strong interest in limiting off-track betting to ensure continued demand for their services."

## JOCKEY AMY DUROSS MAKES GARDEN

**STATE HISTORY** Apprentice jockey Amy Duross, who will lose the bug April 11, made news at Garden State Park Wednesday by becoming the first woman jockey in the track's history to win five races on a single program. The 21-year-old native of upstate New York joins the 20 male riders who have accomplished the feat, including Hall of Famer Sam Boulmetis, who was in the steward's stand Wednesday; Boulmetis notched his five wins in 1959. The record for most wins on a Garden State card is six. Duross was to lose her apprentice allowance in January, but received two extensions to cover riding time lost due to a 1993 injury and to the 17 Garden State dates which were canceled this year. Her five-star night pushed Duross into a tie with Richard Castillo for first in the Garden State rider standings with 25 wins apiece.

## CALDER'S FESTIVAL OF THE SUN

**RESCHEDULED** Calder President Ken Dunn announced yesterday that the Festival of the Sun, the richest day in Florida racing, will be run Saturday, Oct. 15, three weeks before the Breeders' Cup. The Festival was originally scheduled to be run Oct. 8. "We are pleased with the new date for the Festival of the Sun," said Dunn. "Being three weeks out from the Breeders' Cup would have been our first choice, but we wanted to avoid a conflict with the original date of the NYRA's Breeders' Cup Preview." The New York Racing Association had initially planned to run their Breeders' Cup Preview Oct. 15, but changed the date to accommodate an NBC broadcast scheduling conflict.

Trainer Ron McAnally has decided to skip the Santa Anita Derby with **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty), and instead ship to Kentucky for the Apr. 16 Blue Grass. "The weather wasn't a factor at all in making the change," said McAnally. "Our first concern is for the horse. It gives him a little extra time in Kentucky. We aren't ducking anybody. As a matter of fact, we're hitting the Derby favorite (Holy Bull) head on." Trainer Randy Winick, who will saddle morning-line favorite **Brocco** (Kris S.), commented, "The absence of Valiant Nature changes the complexion of the race, no doubt about that. This sets it up pretty well for Fly'n J. Bryan as far as controlling the pace is concerned. There's been pressure on us to do well, especially since he is the Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner, but I'm looking forward to this race and I'm looking forward to Kentucky." Trainer Richard Mandella squashed rumors about San Felipe winner **Soul Of The Matter's** (Private Terms) soundness yesterday, saying, "He had a little filling in a back ankle after his work on the turf last week. But we had it X-rayed, and they were negative. The filling is gone now and he's fine." Mandella also remarked about his Santa Anita Derby runner, "He acts like a good horse. It takes a certain amount of class, brains and soundness to be a great horse and I think he has all those things."
