JEFF LUKAS TO VISIT SANTA ANITA TODAY

Trainer Jeff Lukas, who was seriously injured Dec. 15 when knocked down by Tabasco Cat in the Santa Anita stable area, continues on the road to recovery and will be at the track this afternoon to watch Tabasco Cat run in the Santa Anita Derby. Lukas has been in a Pomona rehabilitation center for five weeks and may be released in a week or two; the 36-year-old horseman is expected to make a near-full recovery. "He is so focused on getting better and getting home; he wants to get back to work very badly," said his wife, Linda. "The doctors keep reassuring the family that the brain cannot heal any faster than Jeff is healing. He had lost a lot of weight, but he is putting it back on. He looks more like Jeff and he's acting more like Jeff."

DOVE HUNT OUT OF GUINEAS Dove Hunt

(Danzig), a top two-year-old on the grass in the U.S. last year who had been expected to make his English debut in the Greenham S. at Newbury next weekend, has suffered a wing fracture of the ilium (a bone in the pelvis) and will miss the 2,000 Guineas. "He will need to be box-rested for some time," said trainer John Gosden. This is the third English Classic hopeful to suffer a pelvic fracture within the last two weeks--both **Bude** (Dancing Brave) and **Stonehatch** (Storm Bird) died as a result of their injuries.

LURE TUNES UP AT KEENELAND Pointing for the \$100,000a Elkhorn S. at Keeneland April 15, Claiborne Farm's **Lure** (Danzig) breezed a comfortable five furlongs in 1:01 2/5 Friday morning at the Lexington oval. The five-year-old will be making his first start since taking his second straight Breeders' Cup Mile last Nov.

SAM HOUSTON RACE PARK JOINS TRA Thoroughbred Racing Associations Commissioner Brian McGrath announced yesterday that Sam Houston Race Park in Texas, North America's newest Thoroughbred track, has become the newest member of the TRA. Sam Houston will begin its inaugural meet April 29.

Burt Bacharach's **Soul Of The Matter** (Private Terms) may have to miss the Santa Anita Derby. "He developed a little skin blister on his pastern from a bell boot I put on to protect his quarter crack," said trainer Richard Mandella. "It is a little tender to the touch and if I don't like the way it looks Saturday, I won't run him. But...I would say it's improved 90 percent since (Thursday) night, so we're hoping for the best, naturally." If the colt should miss this race, he would likely be shipped to Keeneland for the Lexington S. April 24. **Wild Invader** (*Seattle Slew) has been scratched and may travel to New York for the Wood Memorial April 16.

One of the interesting aspects of playing high-profile races is that the percentage of uninformed money is much higher than usual and "name" horses get bet more than they should, creating overlays elsewhere. This year's Santa Anita Derby is a case in point. Although there are no great longshots, the presence of **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) makes for value in the exactas and a playable race.

"He was kind of slow in coming along so I wanted to take some extra time with him and not rush him. It worked once pretty well." Classy Mirage (Storm Bird), winner of the six-furlong Distaff H. last time out, stretches out to a mile for the Bed o'Roses. "I think she's primarily a sprinter," said Jimmy Jerkens, assistant trainer to his dad, Allen Jerkens. "She's probably best going six or seven furlongs, but she could still win it. She has the class to carry her speed."

While he is not a complete impossibility, Tabasco Cat has never run a race in his life fast enough to win this, and is realistically only the third or fourth best horse. **Brocco** (Kris S.), the other favorite, is another story. He's coming up to this race perfectly, and is the best horse. We'll use him on top, and throw out Tabasco Cat. The other contenders are **Soul Of The Matter** (Private Terms), should he run, and **Strodes Creek** (Halo). Soul Of The Matter is better going in, but Strodes Creek is lightly raced and moving in the right direction.
