MINNEHOMA TAKES GRAND

NATIONAL Minnehoma (IRE) (Kambalda {GB}), a 16-1 chance saddled by Britain's champion trainer Martin Pipe, won Saturday's Martell Grand National at Aintree. The 11-year-old gelding, owned by TV comedian Freddie Starr and ridden by Richard Dunwoody, got the better of a thrilling three-way battle on the run-in to beat 20-1 **Just So (AUST)** (Plush {NZ}) by a length and a quarter. **Moorcroft Boy**, 5-1 favourite in the field of 36, was third. Following sweeping changes to the starting procedures, there were no hints of last year's farcical problems. But heavy ground nevertheless took its toll and only six horses completed the four-and-a-half mile course over 30 fences. Apart from the winner, the main headlines were reserved for 51-year-old amateur Rosemary Henderson. Riding her own horse, **Fiddlers Pike (GB)** (Turnpike {GB}), she finished fifth, the best-ever National placing by a woman rider.

FLORIDA HORSE RACING BILLS KILLED

When the Florida legislature adjourned at midnight, April 8, three pieces of business affecting horsemen remained unfinished. Hialeah's efforts to wrestle the prime winter racing dates from Gulfstream died on the House floor. Florida House Bill 2641 would have awarded Hialeah the Jan./Feb./March winter racing dates on alternate years. Instead, the bill died when the '94 legislative session adjourned before it could be voted on. Gulfstream's '95 meet will begin Tuesday, Jan. 3. A bill in the Finance and Taxation Committee which would have permitted casino gambling in Florida, died at the same time when it failed to make it out of committee. A write-in referendum of 430,000 signatures is now necessary to change the state constitution; those signatures have to be filed by Aug. 9. A backstretch medical bill providing health care for grooms and hotwalkers, sponsored by the Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association, was also stalled in the Finance and Taxation Committee.

Tabasco Cat took over from the tiring pacesetter Fly'n J. Bryan (Ogygian) on the far turn, but Brocco came up to challenge at the quarter pole and the two battled down the lane, with Brocco gaining the advantage in the final strides. Ridden by Gary Stevens, the odds-on choice paid \$3.40. "It was his first time going a mile and an eighth, and I just wanted to make sure he finished up running," said Stevens. "He's just a step above everybody else right now. I never really had any doubt about him during the race. But I will say that Tabasco Cat hung in there a little longer than I anticipated. He made a horse race out of it." His fourth career victory moves Brocco's earnings to \$968,550. Trainer Randy Winick indicated that he would ship the 1/2 to Shapiro's Mistress (SW, \$133,110 by Unpredictable) to Churchill in about a week.

SCRATCHES REDUCE SANTA ANITA DERBY FIELD TO SIX **Soul Of The Matter** (Private Terms) was declared out of yesterday's Santa Anita Derby due to the blister on his left front pastern. "I'd rather be safe than sorry," said trainer Richard Mandella. "Maybe I'm being a little foolish, but I don't want to do what's wrong for the horse." Also scratched from the race was **Pollock's Luck** (Polish Navy), who came down with a temperature and a cough Friday afternoon.

BLUE GRASS NOTES Hollywood Futurity winner **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty) arrived at Keeneland at 12:45 p.m. Saturday for next week's Blue Grass S.; he was scheduled to have his first look at the Lexington oval this morning. Two Blue Grass probables breezed at Keeneland yesterday: Louisiana Derby winner **Kandaly** (Alydar) went six furlongs in 1:15 2/5. "I would have hoped he would have gone somewhat faster," said his trainer and co-owner, Louie Roussel III. **Bonus Money** (Chief's Crown) went five-eighths in 1:03, satisfying trainer Harvey Vanier. "He's a fit horse," said Vanier. "He doesn't need a lot of pounding on." Favorite **Holy Bull** (Great Above) is set to work seven furlongs this morning.

Smilin Singin Sam was smokin from the start, leading through fractions of :45 4/5 and 1:09 3/5 en route to a clear victory at 22-1. With jockey Larry Melancon enjoying the ride, the grey earned his second stakes win and paid a generous \$46.60 to his backers. "The race shaped up perfectly," said winning trainer Niall O'Callaghan. "I was a little surprised nobody went with us. This horse will go farther than this, of that I'm sure. I think he'll get even better at the longer distances. As for the Derby, we're going to have to do a lot of talking between now and then and figure out if he belongs or not."

The winner increased his bankroll to \$241,005. Favored Silver Goblin chased the pacesetter to the stretch but tired to finish third; he was scoped after the race and was found to have bled. "I won't run him again for at least three weeks, and then he'll come back on Lasix. There's still alot ahead for him," said his trainer, Kenny Smith, who mentioned the Illinois Derby and then the Preakness for the future.
