BROCCO ON THE VET'S LIST Trainer Randy Winick said Sunday morning that Santa Anita Derby winner **Brocco** (Kris S.) came out of the race in good shape, but California Horse Racing Board veterinarian Dr. B. William Bell put the colt on the vet's list after watching him cool out in the receiving barn, stating that he was off on the right foreleg. "That's his subjective opinion," said Winick. "My vet (Dr. Mike Steppe) saw the horse the first 15 minutes after the race and said he was fine, and I'm telling you the horse is fine. Right now, there is nothing wrong with the horse. Dr. Bell may be a little stricter than my vet. It shocked me, I'll tell you that." Dr. Bell said Brocco was tested at the receiving barn. On a scale of one to 10, 10 being the worst, Bell said Brocco was a one. "It wasn't off much. It could just be a bruised foot, but I'm not in a position to make that decision. If you really weren't looking for it, you really wouldn't see it," said Bell. According to CHRB guidelines, a horse must work at least five-eighths of a mile to the satisfaction of the Official Veterinarian in order to be removed from the vet's list. Winick still plans to ship his Derby hopeful to Churchill Downs at the end of the week. "He ate up everything last night; he didn't miss an oat," said the trainer. "His temperature is good and he's feeling good."

HOLY BULL DRILLS AT KEENELAND Blue Grass favorite **Holy Bull** (Great Above), with exercise rider Bobby Perna up, worked seven furlongs at Keeneland Race Course Sunday morning, getting the distance in 1:28. Fractions for the move were :27 1/5, :52 and 1:15 2/5; the three-year-old galloped out the mile in 1:42. "He got something out of it," said owner/trainer Jimmy Croll. "When he pulled up he was blowing a little bit, which I wanted him to do. If they don't get a little tired, they don't get anything out of it."

Odds-on choice Possibly Perfect, with jockey Kent Desormeaux in the saddle, went up for the lead after three-quarters and held on gamely through the stretch to hold off Pracer by a half-length. It was her second straight GI triumph, her third GI in her last four outings and her sixth career win in 12 starts for earnings of \$626,673. "I wasn't surprised to see another horse on the lead," said Desormeaux. "But my horse is just so tactical it didn't really matter. Coming down the front side, she had her ears pricked forward just looking at the other horses. She was just waiting for me to tell her what to do and, of course, she did it. That's what makes her so good."
