**TRA WAGER GETS NAME, MANAGER** TRA Commissioner Brian McGrath announced that the new weekly national wager to be launched later this spring has officially been named the "National Best Seven." Penn National racetrack has been chosen as the host site of the wager, which will be operated under the rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania State Horse Racing Commission. Jeff Parrott, who previously worked as a computer audit specialist with the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, has been hired to manage and coordinate the National Best Seven. Autotote will install a separate tote system at Penn National to serve as the main hub for all betting on the national wager.

**"SOUL" TO TRY LEXINGTON STAKES** Trainer Richard Mandella said he plans to ship Burt Bacharach's **Soul of the Matter** (Private Terms) to Keeneland Tues. for the GII Lexington S. April 24. Winner of the GII San Felipe S., the West Virginia-bred Soul of the Matter was scratched from Sat.'s GI Santa Anita Derby after developing a skin blister from a bell boot used to protect a quarter crack. Mandella said a good showing in the Lexington would probably earn the colt a trip to the Kentucky Derby. "I've got a good horse that's had enough racing, and that hasn't made any mistakes other than that little bit of lugging in," Mandella said. "I don't want to go (to the Kentucky Derby) so badly that I would compromise the horse, but I want to go."

**WOOD MEMORIAL-GI, \$500,000, 3yo, 9f**  
Nick Zito trainees **Go for Gin** (Cormorant) and **Crary** (Mt. Livermore) experienced eventful gallops yesterday over the Belmont training track, avoiding loose horses while they worked. "They couldn't be better," said Zito. "Loose horses and all. Jorge Chavez was on a horse and he lost his balance; he fell off and Go for Gin galloped right on by him. When Crary was on the track, one of Frank Alexander's horses got loose."  
Trainer Bobby Frankel, who indicated earlier in the week that **Wild Invader** (Seattle Slew) would compete in the Wood, will instead start the colt in the California Derby at Golden Gate the same day. Also skipping the race is Gotham S. runner-up **Bit of Puddin** (Obligato). "The owner (Edwin Wachtel) and I kept going back and forth over the issue and we finally decided to pass the Wood," said trainer Howie Tesher Wed. "He worked well yesterday and came out of it fine, but we began to feel that we should give him a little more time between races. He's got a long year ahead of him and with the long-range plan in mind, we think he'll do better if we nurse him along a bit." Along with Go for Gin and Crary, other probable starters include **Presently** (Affirmed), **Jesse F** (Conquistador Cielo), **Bay Street Star** (Silver Buck), **Code Home** (Lost Code), **Shiprock** (Ga Hai), **Irgun** (Sunny's Halo) and **Our Emblem** (Mr. Prospector). **Ulises** (Temperence Hill), owned by Robert Perez, is listed as possible for the race.

**CALIFORNIA DERBY-GIII, \$200,000, 3yo, 9f**

Gary Jones' trainee **Marconi** (Sadler's Wells), who had been pointing to the Cal Derby, suffered an injury to his left hind and will miss the race and all chance at the Triple Crown. "He smacked a hind ankle during a work," said Jones. "I'm not sure what it is or how long he'll be out. The X-rays were inconclusive. We'll probably have to do a bone scan." **Double Jab** (Rajab), winner of the Feb. 21 Golden Bear S. at Golden Gate, worked a half-mile yesterday in :47 2/5 handily. Jockey Vann Belvoir, who has the call on the Florida-bred colt in the Cal Derby, was aboard. "It was a nice easy breeze," said trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. "Vann let him work a little, but not much." Trainer Mel Stute plans to supplement **College Town** (Snow Chief) to the race at a cost of \$10,000. "It was an oversight on my part not nominating him," said Stute Wed. **Wild Invader** (Seattle Slew) worked four furlongs in :46 3/5 Wed. at Santa Anita. The Bobby Frankel trainee will ship to Golden Gate today. Also set to compete in the Cal Derby are **Bai Brun** (White Mischieff), **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o' Gold), **Gracious Ghost** (Relaunch), **Screaming Don** (Lyphard's Ridge) and **Silver Music** (Silver Ghost). Loblolly Stable's **Warning Label** (Never Tabled) is listed as a probable starter.
