EUROPEAN BREEDERS' CUP BY 1995? Creation of a Breeders' Cup equivalent in Europe is the "first priority" of the European Federation of Thoroughbred Breeders Associations, according to its new chairman Michael Henochsberg. At the federation's first annual general meeting in Paris, Henichsberg said, "I hope to organise, possibly by 1995, a European Breeders' Cup. The programme would include several Group races and two or three handicaps which would be contested by horses from member countries."

FASIG-TIPTON LOUISIANA POSTS GAINS Fasig-Tipton Louisiana held its annual two-year-olds in training and horses of racing age sale at Louisiana Downs April 12. There were 48 horses sold for a gross of \$471,800 and an average of \$9,829, up 28 percent from last year's average of \$7,685. There were 33 horses listed as unsold. The sales topper was a bay colt by Star de Naskra--Princess Fager (Dr. Fager). The two-year-old, who was purchased by James R. and V. Sue Burns for \$41,000, is a half-brother to multiple stakes-winner **Pleasureconnection** (Danzig Connection). The second highest price of \$40,000 was paid by Michael Skipper for **Feelingbetteragain**, a two-year-old filly by Well Decorated--Arrogant Bride (Naskra).

SILVER GOBLIN TO ARKANSAS DERBY **Silver Goblin** (Silver Ghost), third as the heavy favorite in last Saturday's Remington Park Derby, has shipped to Oaklawn and will make his next start in the Arkansas Derby April 23. Trainer Kenny Smith said the gelding came out of the race in good order despite having bled. "Sometimes horses get depressed after they bleed but he's been fine," said Smith, adding, "This race sets up very well for Silver Goblin. I think the speed is in my barn...he can go if no one else does or he can come from off the pace."

"We've got our work cut out for us with **Holy Bull** (Great Above)," said Hall of Fame trainer Ron McAnally, who will saddle Hollywood Futurity winner **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty) for the Blue Grass. "He was just absolutely awesome in the Florida Derby. He's a special horse." Valiant Nature breezed a half-mile in :48 and galloped out five-eighths in 1:01 Thursday. Trainer Harvey Vanier is looking for his third win in the Blue Grass with longshot **Bonus Money** (Chief's Crown). "He's got some talent," said Vanier, who won the event with Play Fellow ('83) and Western Playboy ('89). Speaking of this year's runner, he remarked, "He's a late bloomer. I think he's on the improve, and I think he'll run one of his best races yet." The colt worked a half yesterday in :49. The race will be televised live on ESPN "Racing Across America", which will be shown at 5-6:00 p.m. EDT Saturday. Post time for the Blue Grass is 5:06 p.m. EDT.

Trainer Nick Zito hopes **Go for Gin** (Cormorant) can return to his winning ways after settling for minor awards in his last two races in Florida. "I thought his three races in Florida were very, very good," said Zito. "I couldn't ask him to do much better other than to win all three. In the Fountain of Youth he finished second to Dehere; that day he didn't get a hold of the track. In the Florida Derby he drew post 13--that just wasn't going to be his day." Zito took the 1990 Wood with Thirty Six Red. "I guess you could say now is playoff time, and we have a pretty good playoff record," said the native New Yorker, who also captured the '91 Blue Grass and Kentucky Derby with Strike the Gold. "When we get into the big show, we usually do pretty well. I'm not up for election, but it's been four years since Thirty Six Red. It would be nice to win this." Trainer Steve Young, while admitting his prejudice, feels his Wood hopeful, **Irgun** (Sunny's Halo), is one of the top three-year-olds in the country. "I have a semi-biased opinion, but I would say he is in most people's top ten," he said. "Feeling like I do that this horse hasn't been put to the test yet, he should have more in the tank than those who've been trained harder. He doesn't have as much experience as a lot of horses, but there's nothing I can do about that. He's certainly on the same page as the others."

Devil His Due (Devil's Bag) drops two pounds off his last race, a seventh-place finish in the GI Donn H., but still totes highweight at Oaklawn Saturday. The 7x stakes winner (four GI) was victorious in his '94 debut, taking the GIII Broward at Gulfstream; it was his first win since the GI Suburban last July. Second highweight **The Wicked North** (Far North) has earned all of his stakes wins in California; in his lone trip outside the state last year he was seventh in the Washington D.C. International. Millionaire **Valley Crossing** (Private Account) prepped for this race with a second in an Oaklawn allowance March 26, his first start since November. The race will be televised live on ESPN's "Racing Across America" at 5-6:00 p.m. EDT (not 3-4:00 p.m. as previously reported).
