HOLY BULL, BROCCO, IRGUN TO STAR IN KENTUCKY DERBY

The principal auditions are over and the starring roles for the 120th running of the Kentucky Derby have been cast. With his authoritative victory in yesterday's Blue Grass S., **Holy Bull** (Great Above) has earned top billing in this year's "Run for the Roses;" he will share the spotlight with the speedy but lightly raced **Irgun** (Sunny's Halo), who ran his stakes record to two-for-two with a determined wire-to-wire triumph in the Wood Memorial Saturday, and with Santa Anita Derby winner **Brocco** (Kris S.), who will certainly benefit should the two frontrunners try to upstage each other early at Churchill Downs. The connections of the Derby stars have all expressed confidence that going an extra eighth of a mile the first Saturday in May will be well within reach for their colts. The runner-ups to the top three, **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty), **Go for Gin** (Cormorant) and **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat), respectively, will co-star in the big event, ready to stand-in should the headliners miss a cue. Only two major Derby preps remain: the Arkansas Derby (Apr. 23) and Lexington S. (Apr. 24).

LAKEWAY PREPS FOR KENTUCKY Undefeated three-year-old filly **Lakeway** (Seattle Slew), wearing a bar shoe to protect her bruised foot, worked six furlongs in 1:14 2/5 at Santa Anita Saturday and will ship to Churchill Downs Tuesday, but trainer Gary Jones is still not sure where she will make her next start. "She'll work twice (at Churchill); first seven furlongs, then a mile," said Jones. "I'm still leaning toward running her in the Oaks, but where she runs depends on how the three-year-old colts do in the coming weeks and on how she trains. The main difficulty that I see with the Derby is that she'd be going from a mile and a sixteenth against fillies to a mile and a quarter against colts. That would be kind of tough."

"He would have gone around again today," said jockey Mike Smith, showing complete confidence that his mount, Holy Bull, is up to the ten-furlong challenge of the Kentucky Derby. The grey, a 1/2 to Winnie D. (Crafty Prospector), SW of \$164,500, was never threatened in the Blue Grass, striding to the front at the start and cruising home under a hand ride to win as much the best and pay \$3.20. Smith added, "I think he'll go as far as you want to go, and it'll take a champion to ever beat him."

He finds his composure when a lot of other horses get fired up, and he'll need that in the coming weeks." The colt is scheduled to leave for Kentucky Tuesday; Go for Gin is also likely to go to the Derby.
