SOUL OF THE MATTER PREPS FOR LEXINGTON Burt Bacharach's **Soul of the Matter** (Private Terms) breezed seven furlongs in 1:27 4/5 at Santa Anita Sunday morning, prepping for the Apr. 24 \$125,000 Lexington S. at Keeneland. "It wasn't a fast work, just something to put a little air back into him," said trainer Richard Mandella. "He galloped out in 1:41, and he was a little tired afterward. But that'll probably do him good." Mandella added that the quarter crack and blistered left front pastern which have bothered the three-year-old are "really coming around." Soul of the Matter is scheduled to ship east this evening. "If everything's right, he'll leave Monday night and will probably have one short blowout at Keeneland before the race," said Mandella.

SHOEMAKER ON ESPN'S "UP CLOSE" Trainer Bill Shoemaker will be the featured guest on an upcoming edition of ESPN's "Up Close" with Roy Firestone. The interview will be taped today and is tentatively set to air during Kentucky Derby week.

KEENELAND TWO-YEAR-OLD SALE STARTS TUESDAY Keeneland has catalogued 249 horses for its annual April Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale. Sessions for the two-day auction are scheduled for 1:30 p.m. Tuesday, April 19 and 7:30 p.m. Wednesday, April 20. The total number of horses is 90 more than the 159 catalogued for last year's inaugural juvenile sale. Among the horses sold in last year's auction was Term Limits, last year's champion two-year-old filly in Canada, and Remington Park Derby winner Smilin Singin Sam.
