## CALIFORNIA HORSEMEN WARNED OF ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE IN STRAW

The California Horse Racing Board issued an informational bulletin Thursday concerning scopolamine, a natural plant alkaloid, advising horsemen of the confirmed presence of a weed containing the prohibited substance in bedding straw that was delivered to tracks in Southern California. Scopolamine, commonly used to treat motion sickness in humans, has been identified by Truesdail Laboratories in eight post-race test samples. The names of the trainers involved will not be released until the CHR's ongoing investigation is completed. Scopolamine is found in certain plants native to the United States, such as Henbane and Jimson weed; a sample of straw containing Jimson weed was shown to horsemen attending a CHR meeting at Santa Anita yesterday. Meetings are scheduled at Golden Gate today and at Hollywood Wednesday. Scopolamine has also been detected in at least one racing product, which is no longer manufactured, but horsemen were advised to go through their products and contact the stewards, the official veterinarian, or the CHR if they suspect any product contains scopolamine.

**KRONE BACK ON TRACK** Julie Krone galloped two horses at Belmont Park yesterday morning for trainer Scotty Schulhofer in her first riding appearance at a racetrack since breaking her ankle last Aug. 30 at Saratoga. Krone estimated she would return to competition in about 30 days. "With the second horse, the jitters went away," said Krone. "I felt a little cocky already. A couple of times my ankle burned in the area of scar tissue, not in the joint, but when I got off I felt good. It's still easier to ride than it is to walk."

**DERBY PROSPECTS DRILL AT CHURCHILL** Four of this year's Kentucky Derby hopefuls breezed at Churchill Thursday. The Charlie Whittingham entry of **Strodes Creek** (Halo) and **Numerous** (Mr. Prospector) went five furlongs in 1:03 4/5 and galloped out three-quarters in 1:17 3/5 in company. Remington Park Derby winner **Smilin Singin Sam** (Smile) went an easy half in :51 2/5. **Powis Castle** (Rare Brick) worked a strong seven furlongs in 1:27 2/5.

**GUINEAS** Jockey Pat Eddery received a two-day suspension for careless riding at Beverley Thursday and as a result will miss next Saturday's English 2,000 Guineas. Britain's champion jockey was set to ride **Distant View** (Mr. Prospector) for trainer Henry Cecil; unless he takes the step of lodging an official appeal against the decision, which is rare in Europe, he will sit out racing April 30 and May 1.
