LEMON SOUFFLE OUT OF 1,000 GUINEAS

Lemon Souffle (Salse), Europe's top-rated juvenile filly of 1993 and the winter favourite for next Thursday's 1,000 Guineas, will miss the Newmarket classic after disappointing in a gallop Friday morning. The Richard Hannon trainee was unbeaten until injured while finishing third in last Sept.'s Cheveley Park S.; surgery to repair the hind leg which was damaged when struck during the running of that race was successful and Hannon was more than hopeful of getting her ready in time for the 1,000 Guineas. But she failed to sparkle in a racecourse workout under Lester Piggott at Newbury and will be withdrawn from the event. Piggott said, "She was a little bit disappointing. It has been decided to give her more time. She should be ready to run at Ascot in June." Lemon Souffle will be pointed for Royal Ascot's Coronation S.

ZIGNEW RETIRED

Jack Kent Cooke's **Zignew** (Danzig), who fractured his left front cannon bone after finishing fourth in the Strub S. Feb. 6, has been retired to stud. The four-year-old will stand at Cooke's Elmendorf Farm in Kentucky; the winner of the San Fernando S. ended his career with five wins and earnings of \$285,025.

EDDERY TO APPEAL Pat Eddery will lodge an appeal against the two-day ban which would have cost him the mount on Distant View in next Saturday's English 2,000 Guineas. Eddery received the suspension Thursday when stewards found him guilty of careless riding, but after watching a head-on replay of the race, the champion jockey announced he would appeal. No date has been set for the hearing.

Thoro-Graph Analysis by Jerry Brown

One of the interesting discoveries that Thoro-Graph handicappers have made is what we call the "spring three-year-old pattern," which is a variation of "bounce" handicapping. When a quality three-year-old runs the best race of his life in the spring, instead of bouncing he tends to repeat that effort and bounce the next time. In the fourth race of the sequence he will tend to run back to his previous best race, and sometimes even better. This, in fact, was the pattern that Hansel and Pine Bluff followed, running clinkers in the Derby then big ones in the Preakness.

Several members of the Arkansas Derby field are at different stages of the pattern. **Ride The Rails** (Cryptoclearance) not only ran his best last out, he has had six weeks to sharpen for this. **Blumin Affair** (Dynaformer) just ran a new top, and although short rest might compromise him a little, he probably will repeat that effort. **Silver Goblin** (Silver Ghost), on the other hand, just ran his eyeballs out twice in a row and despite actually being the fastest horse, is very likely to run a subpar race.

The most interesting horse is **Fly Cry** (On to Glory), who is coming up to the last race of his sequence--the payoff. After running good figures to win a pair of small stakes in Louisiana, he bounced as the favorite in the Louisiana Derby. Now his pattern is primed for the payoff--at a price. We'll key Fly Cry back and forth in exactas with Blumin Affair and Ride The Rails.
