SKI PARADISE TAKES JAPAN'S SPRING CUP

Ski Paradise (Lyphard), trained in France by Andre Fabre and ridden by Yutake Take, was a comfortable length-and-a-half winner of yesterday's GII Keio Hai Spring Cup in Tokyo. **Zieten** (Danzig), formerly with Fabre but now trained in Dubai, was second and last year's 1,000 Guineas heroine **Sayyedati** (Shadeed) was back in third in the seven-furlong event. The top three could meet again in next month's GI Yasuda Kinen at the same course.

LAKEWAY BREEZES AT CHURCHILL Mike Rutherford's undefeated three-year-old filly **Lakeway** (Seattle Slew) worked seven furlongs in 1:26 at Churchill Downs Sat., galloping out the mile in 1:40 3/5. "She got a little tired the last eighth," said trainer Gary Jones. "She's never raced over a track that's deep like this, so it's to be expected. She's used to those California tracks, but next time she'll finish up better." The 2x GI winner is still considered possible for the May 7 Kentucky Derby; she is scheduled to work a mile in five or six days.

NEW JOCKEYS FOR GO FO GIN, STRODES

CREEK Trainer Nick Zito, who took the '91 "Run for the Roses" with Strike the Gold, announced yesterday that Chris McCarron would ride his '94 runner, **Go for Gin** (Cormorant). Jerry Bailey had been aboard the colt for seven of his nine career starts, but will ride Wood winner **Irgun** (Sunny's Halo) the first Saturday in May. California hopeful **Strodes Creek** (Halo) will get a new pilot as well, with two-time Derby winner Eddie Delahoussaye replacing Corey Black.

'L.A. LAW TO SHOOT AT SANTA ANITA The t.v. series "L.A. Law" is planning to shoot a scene at Santa Anita for its final episode, which airs on NBC May 14. Darrell Vienna, who trains for "L.A. Law" producer David Milch, will participate.

**Arkansas Derby cont.**

Jockey Garrett Gomez was unconcerned while trailing the next to last horse by as many as 12 lengths early but when he showed Concern the whip, the three-year-old flew past the field and outgamed Blumin Affair (who had been next to last) for the victory. Overlooked by the bettors, the colt paid \$43.40. Trainer Richard Small, enjoying his first winter at Oaklawn, commented, "The horse ran great. Most of his races had been at a mile or a mile and a sixteenth; the little extra distance helped him." But the colt will not be making the trip to Louisville. Small said, "He leaves with the rest of my horses Sunday for Maryland. The Kentucky Derby just comes up too soon. There are some races for this colt in Maryland." The triumph raised Concern's stats to 13-3-4-4 and boosted his bankroll to \$384,820; he is a full to Tennis Lady, GSW, \$188,770. Silver Goblin, on Lasix for the first time, set all the fractions and dug in through the lane but couldn't hold off the top two.

Making his second start of the year, last year's Belmont Stakes winner Colonial Affair let speedster Contract Court open up a clear lead early, then put the pedal to the metal to nail the victory on the wire. Bet down to 3-2, the four-year-old carried Jose Santos to the winner's circle. "At the three-eighths pole, I switched the stick to my left hand and showed it to him and he responded," said Santos. "By the quarter pole we were getting to him, but by the eighth pole I was getting concerned about the weight. We ran really hard to the wire." Trainer Scotty Schulhofer said, "He's developed so much. Last fall, he was just a big, gawky kid. He's still a kid, but he's growing up and he's looking better and moving better; he's just doing everything better." The colt, who now owns a record of 15-5-4-2 and \$915,228, could make his next start in the Pimlico Special.

Trainer Jose Silva isn't predicting victory over **Bien Bien** (Manila) in the San Juan Capistrano, but he is certain that his **Emerald Jig** (Green Dancer) will be in at the finish. The five-year-old has been on the board in 14 of his 16 career starts. "He's a very consistent and honest horse," said Silva. "He runs good every time. Of course, Bien Bien is the horse to beat. But the thing that will help me is the distance. Also, the jockey (Rafael Meza) knows this horse and knows this track. He fits Emerald Jig well." Meza has ridden the Kentucky-bred in his last six starts, with three wins and three seconds. The Golden Gate shipper was second, beaten a nose by Gothland in the San Francisco Mile last time out.

Sunday's Lexington features several up-and-coming three-year-olds on their way to somewhere else. **Oakmont** (Alydar) won a stake in his last, but has done an awful lot of developing in a short period of time and is not likely to immediately improve enough to handle this field. **Ledford** (Forty Niner) lost to Oakmont last time out, but actually earned the same figure--he was wide on the turns, losing as much ground as he was beaten at the wire. Lightly raced and likely to improve, he's almost sure to beat Oakmont this time, but he would have to move up considerably to threaten the top two.

Soul of the Matter (Private Terms) moved to a new level last time out, one that puts him at the border of the Derby picture. With five weeks since the San Felipe he is almost sure to run well, meaning it will take a Grade I level figure to beat him.

When we discussed the Arkansas Derby, we mentioned Thoro-Graph's "spring three-year-old pattern." As it happens, this pattern also applies to the Lexington.

Southern Rhythm (Dixieland Band) developed very rapidly, getting down to graded stakes figures in his third and fourth lifetime starts. Off those, he was favored in the Jim Beam and, as we predicted in this space, he threw in a clinker. Now he is once again ready for a big one, which puts him dead even with Soul of the Matter. Since he will be twice the price of that one, we'll take Southern Rhythm to win. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many horsemen and professional handicappers to evaluate the ability of racehorses.
